3. What is one area of your life where God may be inviting you to trust Him more deeply?
4. What practices or rhythms help you remain attentive to God throughout your week?
5. As you reflect on today's message, what is one invitation you sense God extending to your present circumstances?

Group Reflection Questions

1. What stood out to you most from the Shema, and why?
2. How does the image of moving from a wedding to a marriage help you think about your relationship with God?
3. Can you share a time when God met you in an ordinary moment in an unexpected way?
4. What does it look like, in practical terms, to keep God at the centre of everyday life without it becoming merely another religious activity?
5. How can we encourage one another to live with greater wonder, attentiveness, and expectancy as we follow Christ together?
