

# **TBC OUTDOOR SERVICE AUGUST 9, 2026 and FAMILY STAY N PLAY FAQ**

## **Where will the service be held?**

The service will be held in the grassy bowl behind the church.

## **Is the service going to be held at the regular time?**

Start time at 10:45am and will run for 45 minutes until 11:30am.

## **I cannot attend on August 9. Will the service be livestreamed?**

Unfortunately, due to obvious technical limitations, we will not be able to livestream this service.

## **What if it rains?**

In the event of inclement weather, the service will move indoors, but the times will remain unchanged. Also, if there is poor weather, the Family Stay N Play scheduled for Aug 9 will be postponed for the week after.

## **What should I bring?**

- ✓ **BUG SPRAY!** 
- ✓ Lawn chair (extras if you have some for others who may forget)
- ✓ Hat
- ✓ Sunscreen
- ✓ Umbrella
- ✓ water bottle
- ✓ picnic lunch and a blanket to sit on

## **Can I keep my picnic lunch refrigerated?**

Yes. You are free to keep your picnic lunch in the downstairs kitchen fridge during the church service.

## **What if I forget a camp chair and lunch?**

We will have a limited number of benches and chairs for those who need them, and some simple snacks for those who forgot to pack a picnic lunch.

## **Will Trinity Tots and Trinity Kids be running?**

This is a full family service. Trinity Tots and Kids will not be running, but the Trinity Tots space will be open and accessible from the outdoor service for parents who need to use it self-serve. In lieu of activity boxes, we will have bubbles for the kids to enjoy!

## **What about washroom access?**

Our downstairs washrooms can be easily accessed through the Fellowship Hall doors, then by following the signs.

## **What if I have mobility restrictions?**

People with mobility restrictions can take the elevator on the main floor down to the lower level and access the bowl via the Fellowship Hall doors.

## **Where do I put my weekly offering?**

Physical offerings can be placed in the locked black boxes at the rear of the sanctuary just like every Sunday.

## **What is the Family Stay n Play?**

Families are encouraged to bring a picnic lunch and stay after the service to play in the park or play games which will be set out.
