



Quiet Time Questions from July 19, 2026

Sermon in a Sentence: Even though we are scarred from sin and need reminders along the way, God continues to call us to be sojourners and not settlers in this world.

Verses for Memorization and Meditation: *"The years of my pilgrimage are a hundred and thirty. My years have been few and difficult, and they do not equal the years of the pilgrimage of my fathers." (Genesis 47:9)*

1. **Read Genesis 47:1–6 and John 17:14–16.** In what ways are you tempted to find your identity, security, or satisfaction in this world instead of remembering that your citizenship is in heaven? What practical step can you take this week to live more like a sojourner?
2. **Read Genesis 47:7–10 and Romans 12:2.** Looking back over your spiritual journey, what lessons has God taught you through your failures? How is He renewing your mind today so that future generations are blessed rather than burdened by your choices?
3. **Read Genesis 47:27–31 and Hebrews 10:24–25.** How does your involvement in your church help keep your heart focused on Christ instead of becoming comfortable with this world? Who encourages you to keep your eyes on your eternal home?
