



Quiet Time Questions from July 12, 2026

Sermon in a Sentence: At the crossroads of life, worship brings God's voice to guide us, God's complete faith to move us, and God's wisdom to protect us.

Verses for Memory and Meditation: *"So Israel set out with all that was his, and when he reached Beersheba, he offered sacrifices to the God of his father Isaac."*
(Genesis 46:1)

1. **Read Genesis 46:1-4.** What crossroads are you facing right now, and have you taken time to worship God before making your decision? Spend time thanking God for His faithfulness and ask Him to replace your fear with confidence in His presence and promises.
2. Reflect on how Genesis 46:5-30 shows Israel taking a complete step of faith, leaving the Promised Land completely and heading toward Egypt. Has God already spoken clearly through His Word about an area where you need to take a step of faith? Is there something you have been delaying because of fear or uncertainty? What would it look like to respond with complete obedience instead of partial commitment?
3. **Read Genesis 46:31-34.** In what ways are you being tempted to blend into the "Egypt" around you instead of living as one of God's distinct people? Consider your relationships, priorities, speech, and habits. How can you remain engaged with the world while faithfully reflecting Christ this week?
