



Quiet Time Questions from July 26, 2026

Sermon in a Sentence: Biblical faith is trusting God's promises, knowing His character, and obediently acting on His Word even when His promises have not yet been seen.

Verse(s) for Memorization and Meditation: *“By faith Jacob, when he was dying, blessed each of Joseph’s sons, and worshiped as he leaned on the top of his staff.” (Hebrews 11:21)*

1. **Read Genesis 48:1-4 and Hebrews 11:1.** How do you define your faith? Is it based on the evidence of things hoped for, or just that facts that you can tangibly prove? Is your faith the conviction of things not seen, or believing in only what you can see?
2. **Read Genesis 48:5-14 and Hebrews 11:6.** Do my actions reflect one that has spiritual eyesight? Am I acting as if it is impossible to please God without faith?
3. **Read Genesis 48:15-22 and Hebrews 11:6.** Do you know God as your Good Shepherd, your Provider and Protector? Has He redeemed you, rescued you from evil? Do you walk with Him, continually aligning your lifestyle, thoughts, and actions with God’s will?
