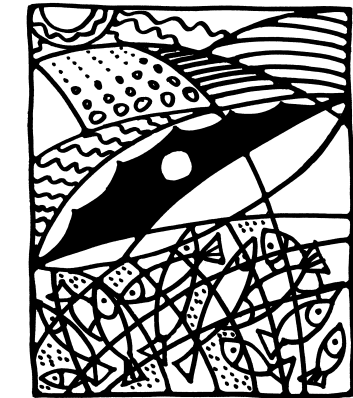


ALL SAINTS BY-THE-SEA

and their encounter with the Creator in this place goes before our own.



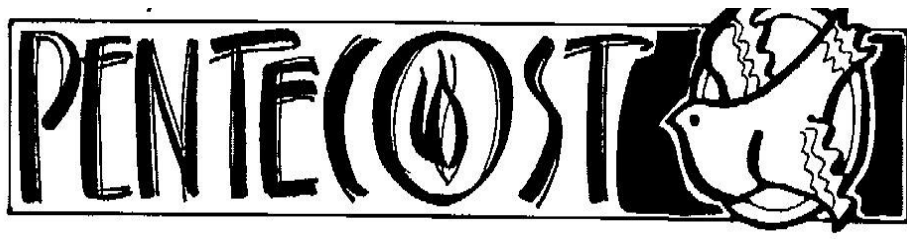

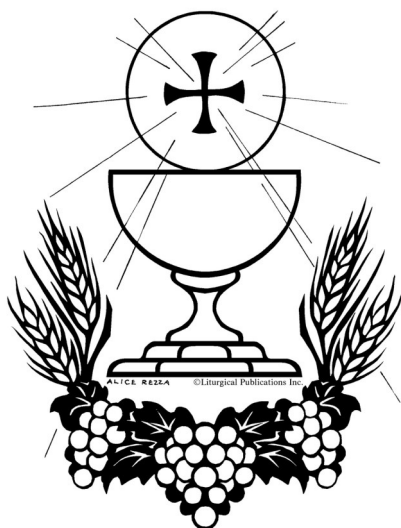
