



Quiet Time Questions from July 05, 2026

Sermon in a Sentence: Joy, which the world needs to see, is fully experienced when we faithfully trust God's purpose, but is delayed by our wounds and hindered by fear and guilt.

Verses for Memory and Meditation: *“So then, it was not you who sent me here, but God. He made me father to Pharaoh, lord of his entire household and ruler of all Egypt.”*
(Genesis 45:8)

1. **Read Genesis 45: 1-8.** What trial or difficulty in my life am I struggling to see from God's perspective, and how does Joseph's story encourage me to trust God's purpose even before I understand it?
2. **Read Genesis 45:1-3.** Am I allowing fear, guilt, or past failures to rob me of the joy God offers through His grace, and what truth from Scripture do I need to believe today?
3. **Read Genesis 45: 16-20.** How can my joy in God's faithfulness become a witness to others this week, helping them see and glorify God through my words, attitudes, and actions?
