Special Guests: Mimi Curry, YFM Director; Wimberly Homeschool Co-op

Mimi Curry: Mimi had several conversations with Rev. Mary Grace Sorenson re: the YFM program. *First*, it is alright to have a teen volunteer in the babies/toddlers room as long as there is at least one certified adult in the room with them. *Second* was about the YFM being in the church service at the beginning, end, or not at all. It was decided to try *not* having them in the service for four weeks. Finn moved, Linda seconded, all said "aye". *Third*, Mimi would like for UoW to host a 'Back-to-School' event. Mimi will present more ideas regarding this at a future meeting.

Wimberley Homeschool Co-op: Three ladies from the co-op program attended. They would like to renew their agreement for use of the building and grounds on Mondays for the upcoming school year. They would also like for us to increase the amount we charge for the use. They confirmed their own liability insurance; parents will sign a liability release for kids to play on the courts. In addition they inquired about the possibility of having campouts in Serenity Gardens. Mike Kemp said he would get with them to discuss what this would entail from both sides, which will include a release of liability signed by attending families. The ladies were reminded that no children were to be in the sanctuary. There are 35 children ages 4-17 years. Susan will decipher a new fee for the use.

Verify Quorum: All present. Michael Finn, Andrea Ballentine, Susan Winkler, Linda McQuinn, Nick Goviacchini and Mike Kemp.

Approval of Minutes: May minutes were approved as written. Finn moved, Andrea seconded, all said "yea".

Items for Discussion:

Ministerial Search Committee Update: Mike. Candidate Michael Monasterial has been reimbursed for his expenses and paid \$150 for being a lay speaker. The congregational surveys have been coming in, submission closes on June 20.

Elizabeth Nachman, second ministerial candidate will be here the weekend of June 26-29.

Mold Remediation: Finn: The cost for just the tear-out and cleaning of the mold in the apartment will be approximately \$12,000, which does not include rebuilding. Finn will ask the mold inspection agency to return to the church and check the rest of the building to determine if the mold has spread beyond the apartment. The renter has moved out of the apartment until such time as the mold has been rectified.

Linda inquired if the mold is a result of proper repairs not being made to the roof due to the insurance company's seeming reluctance to pay. She suggested contacting the Texas Board of Insurance to see if they can help with the situation. Linda will pursue this information.

Roof Update: See above comments.

ByLaw Changes: We went through, and added to, our current bylaws things that are in the Ministries bylaws but weren't in ours. Linda will add these changes and submit the document to Board Members for review.

Manus Concert Update: Terri Prindle submitted Manus' terms for doing a concert in September 2026. Although they were favorable, the Board felt it would be best to wait until 2027 to consider an encore performance. Finn will let Terri know.

Church Directional Signs: Susan and Finn. Susan looked into the price of having new wood signs (like the existing signs) made. The existing kind of signs are the most expensive option; Susan is researching alternatives. Finn is researching where we can put signs out on 3237.

Payroll Admin - B-Square: Susan. B-Square still has Lea McCarn as the administrator. To change this to Aida Pierson B-Square needs approval from the Board of Directors. Susan moved, Linda seconded, all said "aye" for the change to Aida Pierson.

Allowing Teens to Volunteer in baby/toddlers room: This request was discussed and the Board voted to allow, as long as the criteria of a certified adult is adhered to. Andrea moved, Mike seconded, all said "aye".
