Knowing God... And Making Him Known

*...do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward...
you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the
will of God you may receive what is promised. ~Heb 10:35-36*

One of the greatest joys of every CYIA™ training school is watching young people discover that ministry isn't first about what they can do—it's about who God is.

This year, as we gathered to prepare for a summer of sharing the Gospel with children, we spent time studying the attributes of God. Again and again, our students were reminded that the confidence we have in ministry isn't rooted in our experience, our personalities, or even our preparation. It is rooted in the unchanging character of God.

They were reminded that our God is sovereign. Long before a child walks into a 5-Day Club®, He already knows their heart. Every conversation, every invitation, every opportunity rests safely in His hands. What peace that brings when plans change or the results aren't immediately visible!

They were amazed by His kindness and His perfect, long-suffering love. The same God who has patiently pursued each of us, calls us to patiently love every child He places in our path. Some children will hear the Gospel for the very first time. Others may seem distracted or

uninterested. Yet God's love never gives up, and neither should we.

That has been tested already this week as they embarked on their second week of training; this time in a preschool setting filled with lively (read rambunctious), interactive (read non-stop talking and the inability to sit more than 2 minutes in a row) 3 & 4 year-olds!

The exhaustion felt after two hours of ministering to these precious children each evening has given each of them a new appreciation for God's **INEXHAUSTIBLE** patience, love and grace.

What comfort it has been to remember that God is omnipresent. Whether our young missionaries are teaching in a neighborhood park, a church basement, or a community center, they never stand alone. The Lord goes before them, walks beside them, and works through them.

Most exciting of all is knowing God's heart for the lost. Our students have been reminded that only the Holy Spirit can change a life. We cannot convince a child into salvation, but we can

faithfully share the Good News and trust God to do what only He can do. What an incredible privilege to watch Him transform lives!

As I watched these young people worship, pray together, practice their lessons, and encourage one another, I couldn't help but thank God. He isn't simply training teachers for a summer. He is shaping lifelong servants whose confidence rests in Him alone.

As we build disciples this summer, our greatest desire is not simply that children would remember a lesson or a song. We pray they would come to know the God behind every lesson—the God whose character never changes, whose promises never fail, and whose love transforms lives forever.

Thank you for standing with us in prayer. As together we intercede for our missionaries and their ministry, we can be confident that God will accomplish far more than we could ever ask or imagine.
