Sermon: Jonah

Series: Majoring in Minors

Main Idea: Jonah is a narrative of the story of Jonah being sent to Nineveh against his will. We often recall lessons of obedience and repentance, but the book calls us to deeper consideration of the line between judgment and mercy.
