Psalm 1

The Way of the Righteous and the End of the Ungodly

- ¹ Blessed *is* the man
Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly,
Nor stands in the path of sinners,
Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;
² But his delight *is* in the law of the LORD,
And in His law he meditates day and night.
³ He shall be like a tree
Planted by the rivers of water,
That brings forth its fruit in its season,
Whose leaf also shall not wither;
And whatever he does shall prosper.
⁴ The ungodly *are* not so,
But *are* like the chaff which the wind drives away.
⁵ Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment,
Nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.
⁶ For the LORD knows the way of the righteous,
But the way of the ungodly shall perish.

Psalm 1:2 Cross References:

- **Psalm 119:35 (NKJV)** Make me walk in the path of Your commandments, For I delight in it.
- **Joshua 1:8 (NKJV)** ⁸ This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.
- **Psalm 119:1 (NKJV)** Blessed *are* the undefiled in the way, Who walk in the law of the LORD!
- **Psalm 119:97 (NKJV)** Oh, how I love Your law! It *is* my meditation all the day.

Psalm 1:3 Cross References:

- **Genesis 39:3 (NKJV)** ³ And his master saw that the LORD *was* with him and that the LORD made all he did to prosper in his hand.
- **Numbers 24:6 (NKJV)** ⁶ Like valleys that stretch out, Like gardens by the riverside, Like aloes planted by the LORD, Like cedars beside the waters.
- **Job 14:18 (NKJV)** ¹⁸ “But *as* a mountain falls *and* crumbles away, And *as* a rock is moved from its place;
- **Job 29:19 (NKJV)** My root *is* spread out to the waters, And the dew lies all night on my branch.
- **Proverbs 11:28 (NKJV)** He who trusts in his riches will fall, But the righteous will flourish like foliage.
- **Proverbs 11:30 (NKJV)** The fruit of the righteous *is* a tree of life, And he who wins souls *is* wise.
- **Proverbs 15:23 (NKJV)** A man has joy by the answer of his mouth, And a word *spoken* in due season, how good *it is*!
- **Proverbs 21:1 (NKJV)** The king’s heart *is* in the hand of the LORD, *Like* the rivers of water; He turns it wherever He wishes.
- **Isaiah 34:4 (NKJV)** All the host of heaven shall be dissolved, And the heavens shall be rolled up like a scroll; All their host shall fall down As the leaf falls from the vine, And *as fruit* falling from a fig tree.

- **Jeremiah 17:8 (NKJV)** For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, Which spreads out its roots by the river, And will not fear when heat comes; But its leaf will be green, And will not be anxious in the year of drought, Nor will cease from yielding fruit.
- **Ezekiel 47:12 (NKJV)** ¹² Along the bank of the river, on this side and that, will grow all *kinds of* trees used for food; their leaves will not wither, and their fruit will not fail. They will bear fruit every month, because their water flows from the sanctuary. Their fruit will be for food, and their leaves for medicine.”
- **Luke 23:31 (NKJV)** ³¹ *For if they do these things in the green wood, what will be done in the dry?”*

Psalm 1:4 Cross References:

- **Job 21:18 (NKJV)** ¹⁸ They are like straw before the wind, And like chaff that a storm carries away.
- **Psalm 35:5 (NKJV)** ⁵ Let them be like chaff before the wind, And let the angel of the LORD chase *them*.
- **Psalm 83:13 (NKJV)** ¹³ O my God, make them like the whirling dust, Like the chaff before the wind!
- **Isaiah 17:13 (NKJV)** ¹³ The nations will rush like the rushing of many waters; But *God* will rebuke them and they will flee far away, And be chased like the chaff of the mountains before the wind, Like a rolling thing before the whirlwind.
- **Isaiah 29:5 (NKJV)** “Moreover the multitude of your foes Shall be like fine dust, And the multitude of the terrible ones Like chaff that passes away; Yes, it shall be in an instant, suddenly.
- **Jeremiah 13:24 (NKJV)** “Therefore I will scatter them like stubble That passes away by the wind of the wilderness.
- **Daniel 2:35 (NKJV)** ³⁵ Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver, and the gold were crushed together, and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; the wind carried them away so that no trace of them was found. And the stone that struck the image became a great mountain and filled the whole earth.
- **Hosea 13:3 (NKJV)** ³ Therefore they shall be like the morning cloud And like the early dew that passes away, Like chaff blown off from a threshing floor And like smoke from a chimney.
- **Zephaniah 2:2 (NKJV)** Before the decree is issued, *Or* the day passes like chaff, Before the LORD’s fierce anger comes upon you, Before the day of the LORD’s anger comes upon you!
- **Matthew 3:12 (NKJV)** ¹² His winnowing fan *is* in His hand, and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor, and gather His wheat into the barn; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.”
- **Luke 3:17 (NKJV)** ¹⁷ His winnowing fan *is* in His hand, and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor, and gather the wheat into His barn; but the chaff He will burn with unquenchable fire.”

Psalm 1:5 Cross References:

- **Psalm 76:7 (NKJV)** ⁷ You, Yourself, *are* to be feared; And who may stand in Your presence When once You are angry?
- **Psalm 109:7 (NKJV)** When he is judged, let him be found guilty, And let his prayer become sin.
- **Daniel 12:13 (NKJV)** ¹³ “But you, go *your way* till the end; for you shall rest, and will arise to your inheritance at the end of the days.
- **Nahum 1:6 (NKJV)** ⁶ Who can stand before His indignation? And who can endure the fierceness of His anger? His fury is poured out like fire, And the rocks are thrown down by Him.
- **Luke 21:36 (NKJV)** ³⁶ *Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man.”*

Psalm 1:6 Cross References:

- **Exodus 2:25 (NKJV)** ²⁵ And God looked upon the children of Israel, and God acknowledged *them*.

- **Psalms 31:7 (NKJV)** ⁷ I will be glad and rejoice in Your mercy, For You have considered my trouble; You have known my soul in adversities,
- **Psalms 112:10 (NKJV)** ¹⁰ The wicked will see *it* and be grieved; He will gnash his teeth and melt away; The desire of the wicked shall perish.
- **Proverbs 10:29 (NKJV)** ²⁹ The way of the LORD *is* strength for the upright, But destruction *will come* to the workers of iniquity.
- **Isaiah 1:28 (NKJV)** ²⁸ The destruction of transgressors and of sinners *shall be* together, And those who forsake the LORD shall be consumed.
- **Nahum 1:7 (NKJV)** The LORD *is* good, A stronghold in the day of trouble; And He knows those who trust in Him.
- **Romans 7:15 (NKJV)** ¹⁵ For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do.
