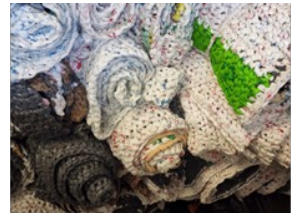

August Mission Links will support Solar Oven Partners Fund

Bringing solar ovens and education to families where fuel costs deplete resources for food and other necessities. Each oven contains three cooking pots, a bread pan, potholders, measuring cups and spoons, a thermometer, plus the Water Pasteurization Instrument (WaPI) for pasteurizing water or milk. Recipients contribute a small donation to get an oven. For 25 years, SOP has distributed more than 24,000 ovens. Demand for ovens continues to grow in the Dominican Republic, Sierra Leone and Four Corners Native American Ministry in Navajo Country. Solar Oven Projects seeks to transition families struggling to make ends meet from fossil-fuel cooking methods to solar cooking methods to save money and improve nutrition.
