Dear Brethren,

Missionary Dani Araya of Costa Rica has shared with me his need for four new tires for his vehicle. If you know Bro. Danny, or if your church supports his ministry, you may feel led to help him with this need. Please continue to pray for his son Pablo, who has undergone a bone marrow transplant, but his body has seemingly rejected the procedure. The doctors have him under observation to see if his hemoglobin levels remain stable, or if they begin to lower once again to the point of needing a blood transfusion. If that happens, they will have to repeat the transplant procedure. Meanwhile, let's continue to pray for Pablo and God's perfect will for his life.

No doubt the trips back and forth to the hospital and doctor's office over the last two years, and not to mention the wear and tear on the tires while carrying out his missionary ministry, has brought him to the point of having this need for new tires. Please consider helping our dear brother with this crucial need. Bro. Danny has been such a valuable help, not only to the Coronado church and mission churches on the field, but also to myself and other missionaries who work with the GPA.
