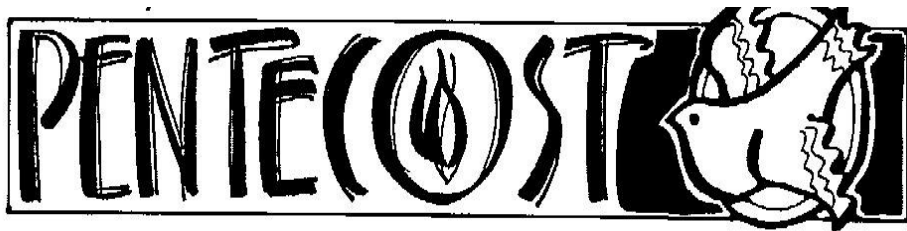

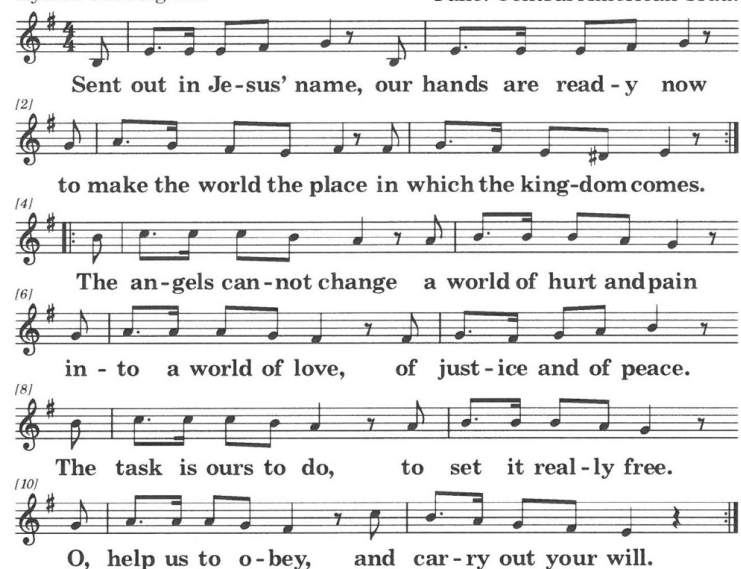

And whose faithfulness en-/dures from/ age to/ age.

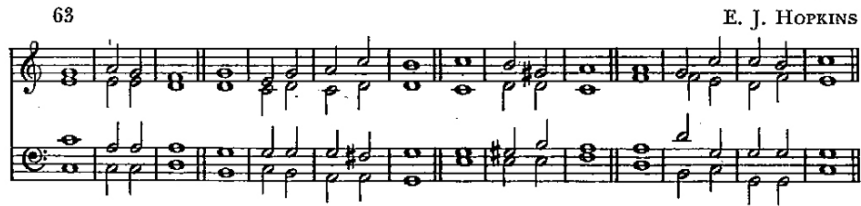

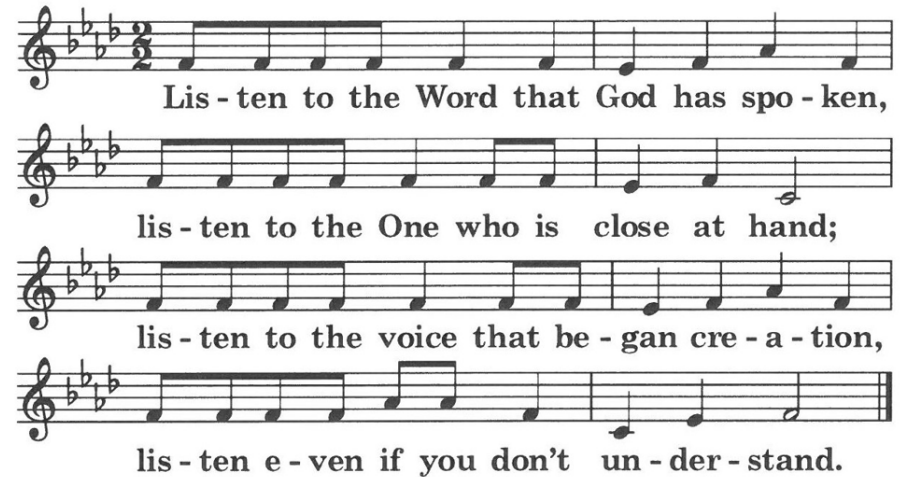
