Many live in homes where basic needs – such as food, safety, clean clothes, and educational support – are not met. Teens wanting to grow in their faith are connected with Christ-centered youth groups, Bible studies, and churches.

Watching a formerly distrustful, sullen, possibly drug-using teenager walk into The Rock each day with a bright-eyed smile ready to be greeted by name, banter with their favorite adults, request a lunch special or their favorite cookie (and knowing we will make it happen for them), and tell us about the constructive things they are doing in their life keeps us striving to make a difference.

The Rock Youth Center was built in 2005 by a local family whose daughter was killed in a drug-related incident. They never wanted another teenager to lack a safe place to hang out, so they bought a house directly across from Bozeman High School, tore it down, and built a bright, sunny, fun space that would be attractive to teenagers. Now over 1000 students per month are served at the Rock – eating low-cost meals; hanging out in a warm, safe, and nurturing space together; doing homework; having adults listen to them and look for ways to bless them; getting encouragement and advice; seeking out leaders who make them laugh or give good hugs; quietly receiving extra food when hungry; and being connected to other services when needed. In addition, the Rock's cafe and commercial kitchen are used by area youth groups, churches, and like-minded organizations most evenings.

Over 50 people volunteer to make this happen, including youth leaders from seven local churches, Fellowship of Christian Athletes leaders, Young Life leaders, and trusted adults who understand the importance of investing in teenager's lives. Many of our volunteers enjoyed hanging out at The Rock when they were in high school and want to keep it going.

As a non-profit 501c3, we have a deeply invested board comprised primarily of successful entrepreneurs, contractors, pastors, and youth directors. These men and women understand the Rock's potential and have us on a course to thrive. Two staff members maintain a consistent presence in the student's lives while fundraising, organizing volunteers, planning meals and events, providing extra academic, emotional, and social support, and connecting students with other services when needed.

With additional support, we can increase our availability to students by being open all day Monday-Friday and organizing tutoring, Bible studies, career counseling, life skills classes, group adventures - all designed to help students see their own potential and worth. On an even bigger scale, we plan to build another Rock directly across the street from Gallatin High School. Our sincere desire is for every student who walks through our doors to know they are known, loved, and encouraged.
