Connect Your Bank Account

Automatic Verification

1. **Choose Your Bank:** You will be prompted to select your bank from a list of popular institutions or search for your bank.
2. **Log In:** Enter your online banking credentials directly into the secure Stripe Connect form. This allows Stripe to instantly verify your bank account.
3. **Confirmation:** Once logged in, you will see confirmation that your bank account has been linked successfully.

Manual Verification

1. **Enter Account Details:** If you prefer manual verification, you can choose to enter your bank account and routing numbers directly.
2. **Verification Deposits:** Stripe (our payment processor partner) will make two small deposits into your bank account within 1-2 business days.
3. **Confirm Deposits:** Log in to your Tithely account and enter the amounts of the two small deposits to verify your account.

2. Enter the donation amount and select the fund.
3. Choose a recurring frequency (such as weekly, bi-weekly, 1st & 15th, or monthly).
4. Select "Credit Card" as the payment method and enter their card details.
5. Complete the required contact information and click "Give" to finish.
