

10 Declarations Over Your Children

1. Fruit of the Spirit

I decree and declare that my children walk in the fruit of the Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Galatians 5:22–23).

2. Love God and Hate Evil

I decree and declare my children love the Lord and hate evil. According to God's Word, their souls will be preserved and delivered out of the hand of the wicked (Psalm 97:10).

3. Honor and Long Life

I decree and declare my children honor their father and mother, and according to God's promise, they will live long upon the earth (Ephesians 6:1–3).

4. Trust in God's Protection

I decree and declare when my children are afraid, they put their trust in God, for He is on their side (Psalm 56:3–4).

5. Guided by the Word

I decree and declare God's Word is a lamp to my children's feet and a light to their path. Their steps hold fast to God's ways, and their feet will not slip (Psalm 119:105; Psalm 17:5).

6. Fruit of Repentance and Humility

I decree and declare that as my children grow into adulthood, they will produce fruit consistent with repentance and walk humbly with their God (Matthew 3:8; Micah 6:8).

7. Wise Companions

I decree and declare my children walk with the wise and not with fools. They will not be unequally yoked with unbelievers, nor form bonds with wrathful people (Proverbs 13:20; 2 Corinthians 6:14; Proverbs 22:24).

8. Light of the World

I decree and declare my children are the light of the world—a city set on a hill that cannot be hidden (Matthew 5:14).

9. Hearing God's Voice

I decree and declare my children hear the voice of the Lord and follow Him. They will not follow the voice of a stranger but will flee from it (John 10:4–5).

10. Blessed in Obedience

I decree and declare my children are blessed because they hear the Word of God and keep it (Luke 11:28).
