Roots and Heritage Parade.. Pray for our students, teachers and staff as they return to school this month.

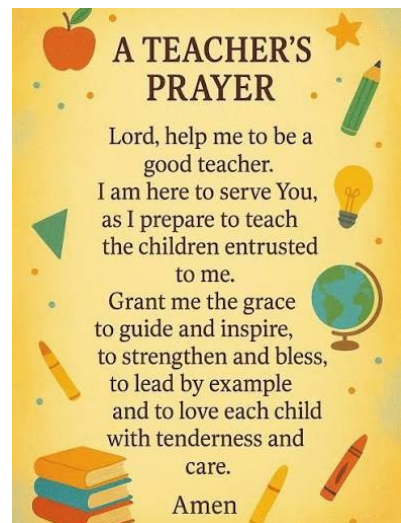
