Now, let's apply this to our own lives:

God did not want Israel to have a King, because God should be there only King, but they complained and whined. In Chapter 10 God gave Israel what they wanted. Verse 19 God makes it clear He is not happy with His people. This is because the people had forgotten all God had done for them and were telling God He was not good enough for them. This is sad, but people still do it today. Let us never forget what all God has done for us!
