Hebrews 1:10 TLB

God also **called** him "Lord" when he said, "Lord, in the beginning you made the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands.

Hebrews 2:11 AMP

Both Jesus who sanctifies and those who are sanctified [that is, spiritually transformed, made holy, and set apart for God's purpose] are all from one Father; for this reason He is not ashamed to **call** them brothers and sisters,

Hebrews 3:1 AMP

Therefore, holy brothers and sisters, who share in the heavenly **calling**, [thoughtfully and attentively] consider the Apostle and High Priest whom we confessed [as ours when we accepted Him as Savior], namely, Jesus;

Hebrews 3:13 AMP

But continually encourage one another every day, as long as it is **called** "Today" [and there is an opportunity], so that none of you will be hardened [into settled rebellion] by the deceitfulness of sin [its cleverness, delusive glamour, and sophistication].

Hebrews 4:7 TLB

But he has set another time for coming in, and that time is now. He announced this through King David long years after man's first failure to enter, saying in the words already quoted, "Today when you hear him **calling**, do not harden your hearts against him."

Hebrews 5:4 AMP

And besides, one does not appropriate for himself the honor [of being high priest], but he who is **called** by God, just as Aaron was.

Hebrews 5:5 BSB

So also Christ did not take upon Himself the glory of becoming a high priest, but He was **called** by the One who said to Him: "You are My Son; today I have become Your Father."

Hebrews 5:10 KJV

Called of God an high priest after the order of Melchisedec.

Hebrews 6:16 TLB

When a man takes an oath, he is **calling** upon someone greater than himself to force

him to do what he has promised or to punish him if he later refuses to do it; the oath ends all argument about it.

Hebrews 7:11 KJV

If therefore perfection were by the Levitical priesthood, (for under it the people received the law,) what further need was there that another priest should rise after the order of Melchisedec, and not be **called** after the order of Aaron?

Hebrews 9:1 TLB

Now in that first agreement between God and his people there were rules for worship and there was a sacred tent down here on earth. Inside this place of worship there were two rooms. The first one contained the golden candlestick and a table with special loaves of holy bread upon it; this part was **called** the Holy Place.

Hebrews 9:2 AMP

A tabernacle (sacred tent) was put up, the outer one or first section, in which were the lampstand and the table with [its loaves of] the sacred showbread; this is **called** the Holy Place.

Hebrews 9:3 BSB

Behind the second curtain was a room **called** the Most Holy Place,

Hebrews 9:4 TLB

In that room there were a golden incense-altar and the golden chest, **called** the ark of the covenant, completely covered on all sides with pure gold. Inside the ark were the tablets of stone with the Ten Commandments written on them, and a golden jar with some manna in it, and Aaron's wooden cane that budded.

Hebrews 9:5 TLB

Above the golden chest were statues of angels **called** the cherubim-the guardians of God's glory-with their wings stretched out over the ark's golden cover, **called** the mercy seat. But enough of such details.

Hebrews 9:15 AMP

For this reason He is the Mediator and Negotiator of a new covenant [that is, an entirely new agreement uniting God and man], so that those who have been **called** [by God] may receive [the fulfillment of] the promised eternal inheritance, since a death has taken place [as the payment] which redeems them from the sins committed under the obsolete first covenant.

Hebrews 10:32 KJV

But **call** to remembrance the former days, in which, after ye were illuminated, ye

endured a great fight of afflictions;

Hebrews 11:8 AMP

By faith Abraham, when he was **called** [by God], obeyed by going to a place which he was to receive as an inheritance; and he went, not knowing where he was going.

Hebrews 11:15 NKJV

And truly if they had **called** to mind that country from which they had come out, they would have had opportunity to return.

Hebrews 11:16 AMP

But the truth is that they were longing for a better country, that is, a heavenly one. For that reason God is not ashamed [of them or] to be **called** their God [even to be surnamed their God—the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob]; for He has prepared a city for them.

Hebrews 11:18 AMP

to whom it was said, “THROUGH ISAAC YOUR DESCENDANTS SHALL BE **CALLED**.”

Hebrews 11:24 AMP

By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be **called** the son of Pharaoh’s daughter,

Hebrews 13:22 AMP

I **call** on you, brothers and sisters, listen [patiently] to this message of exhortation and encouragement, for I have written to you briefly.
