Acts 13:3-7 AMP

[3] Then after fasting and praying, they laid their hands on them [in approval and dedication] and sent them away [on their first journey]. [4] So then, being sent out by the Holy Spirit, they went down to Seleucia, and from there they sailed to Cyprus. [5] When Barnabas and Saul arrived at Salamis, they began to **preach the word** of God [proclaiming the message of eternal salvation through faith in Christ] in the synagogues of the Jews; and they also had John [Mark] as their assistant. [6] When they had traveled through the entire island [of Cyprus] as far as Paphos, they found a sorcerer, a Jewish false prophet named Bar-Jesus, [7] who was [closely associated] with the proconsul [of the province], Sergius Paulus, an intelligent and sensible man. He called for Barnabas and Saul and wanted to hear the word of God [concerning eternal salvation through faith in Christ].

Acts 13:42-46 TLB

[42] As the people left the synagogue that day, they asked Paul to return and speak to them again the next week. [43] And many Jews and godly Gentiles who worshiped at the synagogue followed Paul and Barnabas down the street as the two men urged them to accept the mercies God was offering. [44] The following week almost the entire city turned out to hear them **preach the Word** of God. [45] But when the Jewish leaders saw the crowds, they were jealous, and cursed and argued against whatever Paul said. [46] Then Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly and declared, "It was necessary that this Good News from God should be given first to you Jews. But since you have rejected it and shown yourselves unworthy of eternal life—well, we will offer it to Gentiles.

Acts 16:4-9 KJV

[4] And as they went through the cities, they delivered them the decrees for to keep, that were ordained of the apostles and elders which were at Jerusalem. [5] And so were the churches established in the faith, and increased in number daily. [6] Now when they had gone throughout Phrygia and the region of Galatia, and were forbidden of the Holy Ghost to **preach the word** in Asia, [7] After they were come to Mysia, they assayed to go into Bithynia: but the Spirit suffered them not. [8] And they passing by Mysia came down to Troas. [9] And a vision appeared to Paul in the night; There stood a man of Macedonia, and prayed him, saying, Come over into Macedonia, and help us.

2 Timothy 4:1-3 AMP

[1] I solemnly charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge

the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom: [2] **preach the word** [as an official messenger]; be ready when the time is right and even when it is not [keep your sense of urgency, whether the opportunity seems favorable or unfavorable, whether convenient or inconvenient, whether welcome or unwelcome]; correct [those who err in doctrine or behavior], warn [those who sin], exhort and encourage [those who are growing toward spiritual maturity], with inexhaustible patience and [faithful] teaching. [3] For the time will come when people will not tolerate sound doctrine and accurate instruction [that challenges them with God's truth]; but wanting to have their ears tickled [with something pleasing], they will accumulate for themselves [many] teachers [one after another, chosen] to satisfy their own desires and to support the errors they hold,
