The Chase Life Group

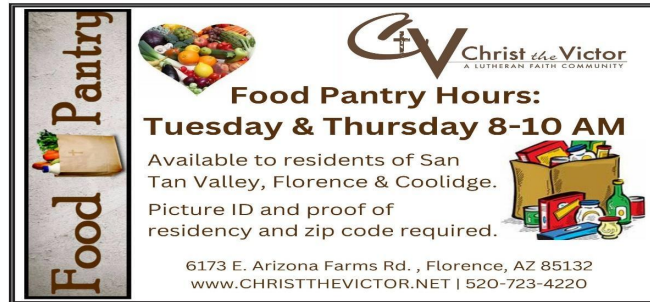
