Starting this week we will have a 6 week sermon series on Galatians – Faith Triumphs Over the Law

“Galatians stands as an eloquent and vigorous apologetic for the essential NT truth that man is justified through faith in Jesus Christ- by nothing less and nothing more- and that he is sanctified not by legalistic works but by the obedience that comes from faith in God’s work for him, in him and through him by the grace and power of Christ and the Holy Spirit. It was the rediscovery of the basic message of Galatians that brought about the Reformation. Galatians is often referred to as “Luther’s Book,” because Martin Luther relied so strongly on this letter in his writings and arguments against the prevailing theology of his day. A key verse is 2:16.”
