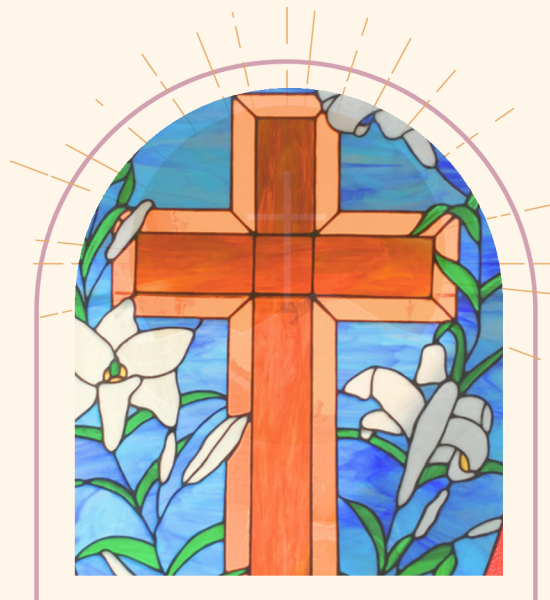

What is Pastoral Care?

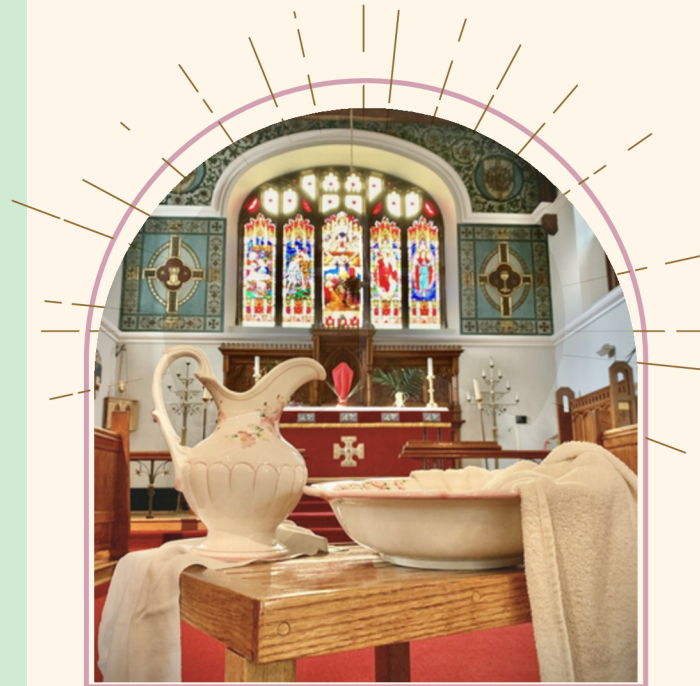
Pastoral Care is reaching out, in the name of Christ, to welcome, serve and care for fellow members of our church family in times of need and crisis.

Through a ten-week course offered by the Ottawa Pastoral Care Training Program, team members have received help in developing both their listening skills and the ability to respond pastorally. Emphasis is also placed on the importance of maintaining confidentiality.

Members regularly attend continuing education events.

What Does the Pastoral Care Team Do?

The Pastoral Care Team ministers through listening, affirmation and prayer. Visits are offered to those who are ill at home, hospital, retirement home or nursing home; lonely or discouraged; those who cannot get to church; or those who are experiencing a challenge in their life and would benefit from the support of a caring Christian friend
