



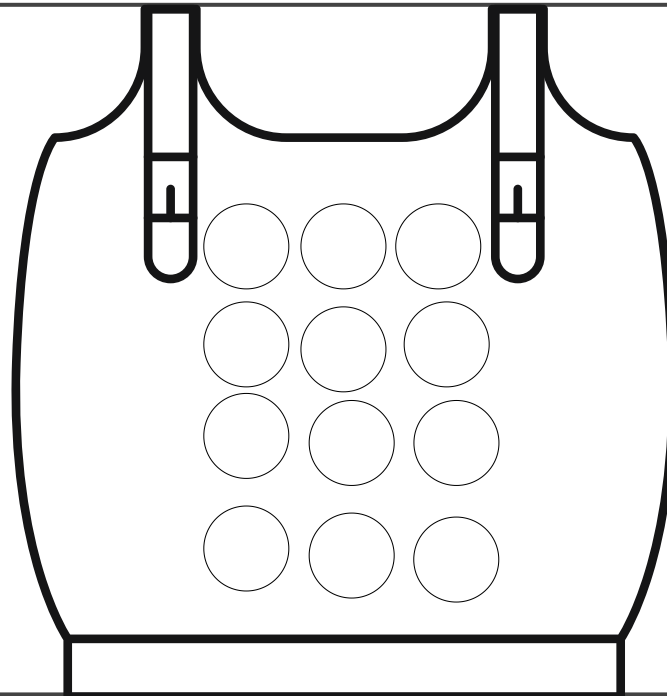
1 SAMUEL 14
