1. Paul names 26 ordinary believers in Romans 16. Which name or story stood out to you most, and why do you think Paul took the time to honour them?
2. Phoebe, Priscilla and Aquila, Mary, Junia, Rufus' mother — none were famous, but all were faithful. Where have you seen God use an "ordinary person" to make an extraordinary difference in your life?

3. Romans 16 shows a wide range of gifts — hospitality, teaching, serving, encouraging, suffering, nurturing. What gift or role has God placed in your hands right now, and how could you use it more intentionally?
4. Comparison kills calling. Where do you most feel the temptation to compare your role to someone else's, and what helps you stay focused on your own calling?
5. Paul's "holy kiss" was a sign of belonging, unity, and family. What would it look like for our church to greet one another with that same spirit of warmth, honour, and genuine love?
6. Romans 16 is a picture of ordinary believers whose yes to God shaped the early church. What is one small, faithful "yes" you could give God this week that might matter more than you realise?
