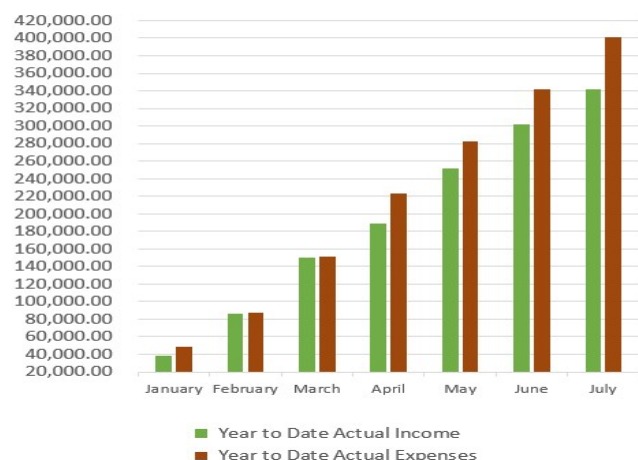

Heart to Heart presents \$1,000 donation to Pasco Kids First

Pasco Kids First provides child abuse prevention, intervention and treatment services in a child friendly, welcoming environment that is private and physically and psychologically safe. Their Child Protection Team provides diagnostic assessments on child abuse by medical and social service personnel. Their Trauma Treatment Team provides victim advocacy and specialized therapy for child victims of sexual and physical abuse. Jessica Smalley led us on a tour and we were joined by the facility's doctor. As we toured their facility, we were moved by the hall walls where t-shirts decorated by victims were displayed. Clients are referred by sheriff and police as well as hospitals and schools. As with many service organizations, their funding has been cut drastically.
