And, if our unrighteousness God's righteousness doth establish, what shall we say? is God unrighteous who is inflicting the wrath? (after the **manner** of a man I speak)

Romans 3:29 TLB

And does God save only the Jews in this way? No, the Gentiles, too, may come to him in this same **manner**.

Romans 6:19 KJVS

I speak after the **manner** of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness.

Romans 7:8 KJVS

But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all **manner** of concupiscence. For without the law sin was dead.

Romans 8:26 YLT

And, in like **manner** also, the Spirit doth help our weaknesses; for, what we may pray for, as it behoveth [us], we have not known, but the Spirit himself doth make intercession for us with groanings unutterable,

Romans 16:2 HCSB

So you should welcome her in the Lord in a **manner** worthy of the saints and assist her in whatever matter she may require your help. For indeed she has been a benefactor of many-and of me also.

1 Corinthians 3:3 YLT

for yet ye are fleshly, for where [there is] among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not fleshly, and in the **manner** of men do walk?

1 Corinthians 4:1 LSB

Let a man consider us in this **manner**, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.

1 Corinthians 7:3 YLT

to the wife let the husband the due benevolence render, and in like **manner** also the wife to the husband;

1 Corinthians 7:4 YLT

the wife over her own body hath not authority, but the husband; and, in like **manner** also, the husband over his own body hath not authority, but the wife.

1 Corinthians 7:7 KJVS

For I would that all men were even as I myself. But every man hath his proper gift of God, one after this **manner**, and another after that.

1 Corinthians 7:17 LSB

Only, as the Lord has assigned to each one, as God has called each, in this **manner** let him walk. And so I direct in all the churches.

1 Corinthians 7:22 YLT

for he who [is] in the Lord -- having been called a servant -- is the Lord's freedman: in like **manner** also he the freeman, having been called, is servant of Christ:

1 Corinthians 11:25 KJVS

After the same **manner** also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.

Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good **manners**.

2 Corinthians 5:7 AMP

for we walk by faith, not by sight [living our lives in a **manner** consistent with our confident belief in God's promises]—

2 Corinthians 7:9 KJVS

Now I rejoice, not that ye were made sorry, but that ye sorrowed to repentance: for ye were made sorry after a godly **manner**, that ye might receive damage by us in nothing.

2 Corinthians 7:11 NKJV

For observe this very thing, that you sorrowed in a godly **manner**: What diligence it produced in you, what clearing of yourselves, what indignation, what fear, what vehement desire, what zeal, what vindication! In all things you proved yourselves to be clear in this matter.

But it is good always to be zealously sought in a commendable **manner**, and not only when I am present with you.

Philippians 1:27 AMP

Only [be sure to] lead your lives in a **manner** [that will be] worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I do come and see you or remain absent, I will hear about you that you are standing firm in one spirit [and one purpose], with one mind striving side by side [as if in combat] for the faith of the gospel.

Philippians 4:1 HCSB

So then, my brothers, you are dearly loved and longed for-my joy and crown. In this **manner** stand firm in the Lord, dear friends.

Colossians 1:10 AMP

so that you will walk in a **manner** worthy of the Lord [displaying admirable character, moral courage, and personal integrity], to [fully] please Him in all things, bearing fruit in every good work and steadily growing in the knowledge of God [with deeper faith, clearer insight and fervent love for His precepts];

Colossians 2:13 AMP

When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your flesh (worldliness, **manner** of life), God made you alive together with Christ, having [freely] forgiven us all our sins,

1 Thessalonians 1:5 KJVS

For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what **manner** of men we were among you for your sake.

1 Thessalonians 1:9 KJVS

For they themselves shew of us what **manner** of entering in we had unto you, and

how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God;

1 Thessalonians 2:12 LSB

so that you would walk in a **manner** worthy of the God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.

2 Thessalonians 2:3 YLT

let not any one deceive you in any **manner**, because -- if the falling away may not come first, and the man of sin be revealed -- the son of the destruction,

2 Thessalonians 3:6 LSB

Now we command you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you keep away from every brother who walks in an unruly **manner** and not according to the tradition which they received from us.

2 Thessalonians 3:7 AMP

For you yourselves know how you ought to follow our example, because we did not act in an undisciplined or inappropriate **manner** when we were with you [we were never idle or lazy, nor did we avoid our duties],

Ministrants -- in like **manner** grave, not double-tongued, not given to much wine, not given to filthy lucre,

1 Timothy 3:11 YLT

Women -- in like **manner** grave, not false accusers, vigilant, faithful in all things.

1 Timothy 5:25 YLT

in like **manner** also the right works are manifest beforehand, and those that are otherwise are not able to be hid.

2 Timothy 3:10 KJVS

But thou hast fully known my doctrine, **manner** of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, patience,

Titus 2:3 YLT

aged women, in like **manner**, in deportment as doth become sacred persons, not false accusers, to much wine not enslaved, of good things teachers,

Titus 2:6 YLT

The younger men, in like **manner**, be exhorting to be sober-minded;

Hebrews 1:1 KJVS

God, who at sundry times and in divers **manners** spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,

Hebrews 2:14 AMP

Therefore, since [these His] children share in flesh and blood [the physical nature of mankind], He Himself in a similar **manner** also shared in the same [physical nature, but without sin], so that through [experiencing] death He might make powerless (ineffective, impotent) him who had the power of death—that is, the devil—

Hebrews 4:15 YLT

for we have not a chief priest unable to sympathise with our infirmities, but [one] tempted in all things in like **manner** -- apart from sin;

Hebrews 6:9 NKJV

But, beloved, we are confident of better things concerning you, yes, things that accompany salvation, though we speak in this **manner**.

Hebrews 7:11 AMP

Now if perfection [a perfect fellowship between God and the worshiper] had been attained through the Levitical priesthood (for under it the people were given the Law) what further need was there for another and different kind of priest to arise, one in the **manner** of Melchizedek, rather than one appointed to the order of Aaron?

Hebrews 9:21 YLT

and both the tabernacle and all the vessels of the service with blood in like **manner** he did sprinkle,

Hebrews 10:25 KJVS

Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the **manner** of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

James 1:24 KJVS

For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what **manner** of man he was.

James 2:25 YLT

and in like **manner** also Rahab the harlot -- was she not out of works declared righteous, having received the messengers, and by another way having sent forth?

James 3:10 AMP

Out of the same mouth come both blessing and cursing. These things, my brothers, should not be this way [for we have a moral obligation to speak in a **manner** that reflects our fear of God and profound respect for His precepts].

1 Peter 1:11 KJVS

Searching what, or what **manner** of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.

1 Peter 1:15 KJVS

But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all **manner** of conversation;

1 Peter 3:1 YLT

In like **manner**, the wives, be ye subject to your own husbands, that even if certain are disobedient to the word, through the conversation of the wives, without the word, they may be won,

1 Peter 3:5 KJVS

For after this **manner** in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands:

1 Peter 3:7 YLT

The husbands, in like **manner**, dwelling with [them], according to knowledge, as to a weaker vessel -- to the wife -- imparting honour, as also being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers be not hindered.

1 Peter 5:5 YLT

In like **manner**, ye younger, be subject to elders, and all to one another subjecting yourselves; with humble-mindedness clothe yourselves, because God the proud doth resist, but to the humble He doth give grace;

2 Peter 3:11 KJVS

Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what **manner** of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness,

1 John 2:6 LSB

the one who says he abides in Him ought himself to walk in the same **manner** as He

walked.

1 John 3:1 KJVS

Behold, what **manner** of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.

3 John 1:6 AMP

and they have testified before the church of your love and friendship. You will do well to [assist them and] send them on their way in a **manner** worthy of God.

Jude 1:7 KJVS

Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like **manner**, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

Jude 1:8 YLT

In like **manner**, nevertheless, those dreaming also the flesh indeed do defile, and lordship they put away, and dignities they speak evil of,

Revelation 8:12 YLT

And the fourth messenger did sound, and smitten was the third of the sun, and the third of the moon, and the third of the stars, that darkened may be the third of them, and that the day may not shine -- the third of it, and the night in like **manner**.

Revelation 11:5 KJVS

And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this **manner** be killed.
