Remember God's Faithfulness

I. Reason for Faith (1-11)

Remember God's faithfulness to you so that you remain faithful to God.

II. Reason for Fear (12-16)

Remember God's faithfulness to you so that you remain faithful to God.

2. Read Joshua 23:12-16. What "if-then" warning does Joshua give in verses 12-13?

What "if-then" warning does he give in verses 15-16?

Has God given us an "if-then" warning? Explain.

3. How is Jesus good news for our failures to be faithful to God?
