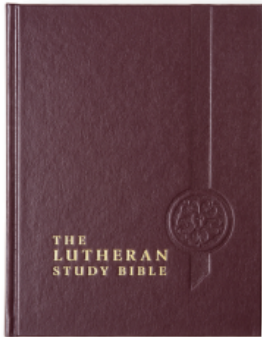

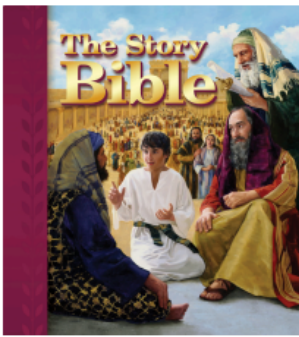

It's bittersweet.

On the other hand, the little sister is now learning from her big brother as he reads her a story from his own Bible story book.

Growing up often means greeting new tasks with enthusiasm and setting past favorites aside.

Growing Independence

If you know a 7- or 8-year-old well, you have probably noticed many changes in the last few years. They have progressed from prereaders who needed lots of support and guidance with reading and other learning activities. Now they have become essentially independent readers who may need some assistance with new concepts or difficult words but who can perform many tasks independently.

In addition to a growing independence in learning, 7- and 8-year-olds exhibit additional independence related to their worship and spiritual lives. These changes include the following:

- Children at this age can memorize prayers and follow along with prayers in church. They can participate in and lead prayers for family devotions.
- During the worship service, they can participate in responsive portions of the liturgy and follow along with the Scripture readings.
- Children are perfecting their ability to memorize longer Bible verses and sections of the Small Catechism.
- They enjoy singing but may feel they are outgrowing songs with actions or "silly" motions. Elementary children enjoy learning new hymns and singing along in worship. They may also be able to sing with others in a canon, with two voice parts at the same time.
- Children in this age category enjoy finding ways they can contribute to worship with their musical abilities. This could include singing ensemble vocals and playing rhythm instruments, strings, simple wind instruments, or simple keyboard settings.

Gifts to Share

As you continue to involve yourself and your children in the *Words of Worship* program, we encourage you to look for and celebrate these milestones of spiritual growth and development. Children need to know the importance of their participation in worship and the special gifts they can share with others.
