Discussion questions:

Why is the Christian life better compared to a long race than a sprint? What does it look like to "stay the course" in everyday life?

How can the sins and disobedience of a nation affect faithful Christians even when they are personally seeking to obey God?

What does it mean to stand, speak up, and continue following Christ when the culture around us moves away from God?

Why should believing that Jesus is returning make Christians more active in ministry and evangelism rather than less active?

The sermon ends by saying, “In our personal obedience, we build the church. In our personal calling we fulfill the mission.” What has God placed in your immediate proximity—home, work, school, neighborhood, or friendships—where you can faithfully serve Him this week?
