A new schedule for Eucharistic Bread Baking is being drafted, to begin in September. If anyone would like to explore this ministry, please speak to or email Rev Jordan.



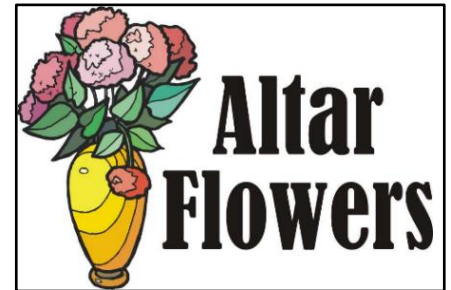
Morning Coffee Group in the Fireside Lounge

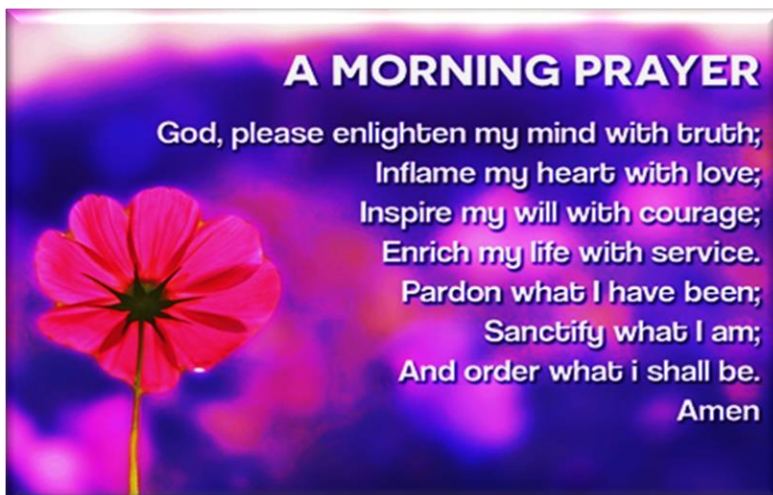

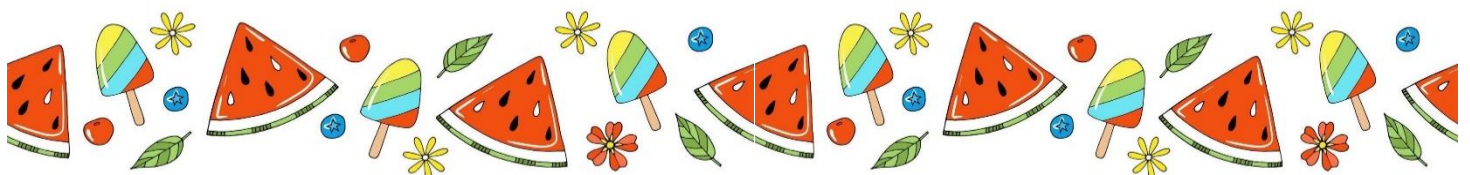

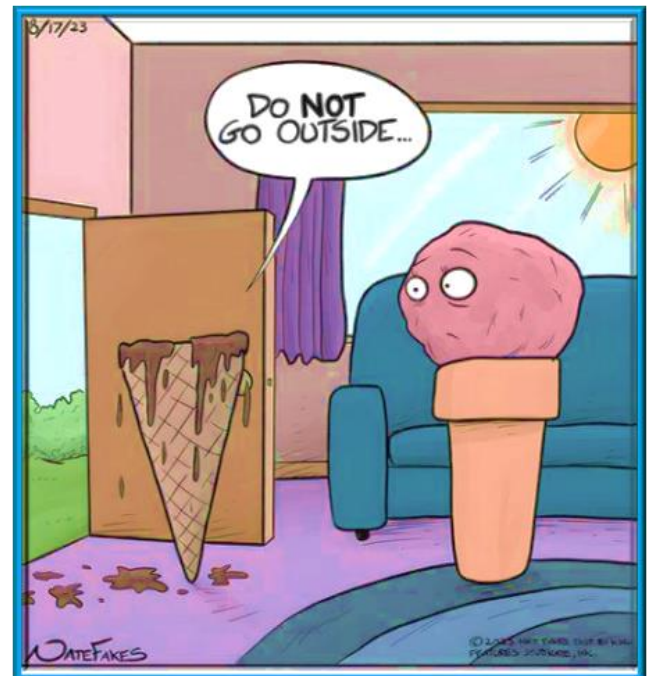
SUMMER PRAYER
