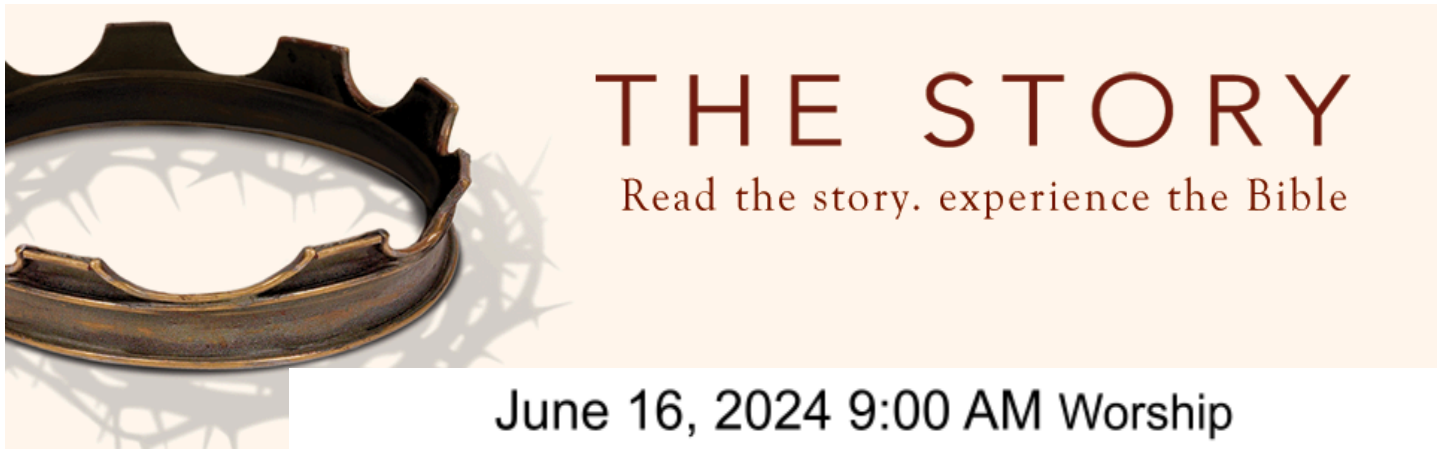

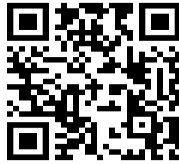

Life Group's

Over the past couple of weeks, I have asked you to pray about your future participation in Life Groups. Deacon John and I fervently believe with all our heart that these relational groups are key to building **Authentic Relationships** and a culture of **Generational Discipleship** within Christ the Victor Lutheran Church. These groups become your 'family away from family,' your 'inner circle' within the larger body of Christ that is CtV.

A sign up sheet is available at the Welcome Booth and via this link for you to indicate how you would like to participate. Each group will need a "Host" who opens their home, a "Facilitator" to help lead and guide discussion, and of course "Participants." There's even room for a Fun Captain who has the gift of hospitality if the Host doesn't want to take on that role.

The Chase Life Group meets monthly, Lori Stenerson and Darla Weiland's is talking about meeting every other week, but there's really no rules to this. Each group is welcome to determine how often they will meet and whether or not it will always be at the same place or if the Host Site will rotate within the group.

We encourage you to start meeting immediately, but Deacon John and I are hoping that we'll have at least three more established by the beginning of September. And to all our Winter friends out there, we encourage you to join or start new groups when you get back.

Deacon John and I will provide some guidelines and some structure for these groups and even volunteer to meet with your groups the first couple times to get you off to a good start.
