PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

Empowered by God — Responding by Grace

Now as you excel in everything — in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in utmost eagerness, and in our love for you — so we want you to excel also in this generous undertaking (2 Cor. 8:7).

It's September, which means it's time for our annual generosity campaign. This year, the theme is "Empowered by God — Responding by Grace." During this time, we will consider how God has empowered us and how our response, by grace through faith, can be used by God, especially in the ministry here at Shalom Lutheran Church.

Power can be a tricky concept for church folks like us. When we think of power, what often comes to mind is the classic quote from Lord Acton: "Power tends to corrupt, and absolute power corrupts absolutely." We might think of totalitarian government or crooked politicians. But this is not the whole story. Power simply refers to one's ability to act.

And the power we receive from the Holy Spirit gives us an ability to act for the sake of the kingdom of God. The Spirit's power "gives life to the dead and calls into existence the things that do not exist" (Rom. 4:17). It is the power that Jesus spoke of right before he ascended to his Father: "...you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8). It is the power spoken by an elderly Paul to his protégé Timothy: "...for God did not give us a spirit of cowardice but rather a spirit of power and of love and of self-discipline" (2 Tim. 1:7). We received this Spirit of power on the day of our baptism, and we renew that power every time we hear God's Word and share the Lord's Supper.

The Spirit also gives us the power to respond to God's amazing grace. We have all been blessed beyond measure by God. And we are empowered to respond by giving what God has given us. A classic prayer from the *Lutheran Book of Worship* says, "...we offer to you what you have first given us: our selves, our time, and our possessions, signs of your gracious love...." We give not out of fear or obligation, but out of the gracious love God has shown us.

There are many things in which we excel at Shalom Lutheran Church. We're a congregation that cares for each other through Outreach and Caring, home communion visits, and many other things. We also care for others through our other ministries for Love INC, the Food Shelf, OBA, and many others. The Jeremiah 29 Project is taking shape as the Runestone Children's Chorus, which will rehearse and perform in our building. We take the Word of God seriously by gathering around it in Bible and catechism study.

Motion was made to approve agenda with amendments by Ken, seconded by Corey, and carried unanimously. Motion was made to approve the June 15th, 2026 Council minutes by Ken, seconded by Julie and carried unanimously.

Reviewed reports by Pastor and Committees:

****Pastor's Report:** Report included in packet. Pastor has continued to provide guidance to the Runestone Chorus on implementing a children's chorus.

**** Finance:** Report in packet from Treasurer. General fund giving rose slightly again this month but total for the year is still behind budget. Building fund giving is slightly below budget.

Summary:

This Shalom reporting is through July with a combined General and Building Funds deficit of \$23,351; primarily due to below-budget General fund offerings and Annual ELCA dues paid in July. Spring/26 Bldg Fund receipts reflect a large 1-time offering. The General/Bldg Funds balance is \$104,528; about \$3,300 below Dec/25; mostly due low below-budget offerings offset by a recent \$20k estate gift that was transferred into the Building fund from Memorial Funds. See Note 7 below for BBQ sales.

Thanks to all who filled LWR school book bags!! As of August 15, 71 bags have been filled and returned. School bags and quilts will be shipped to LWR in October.

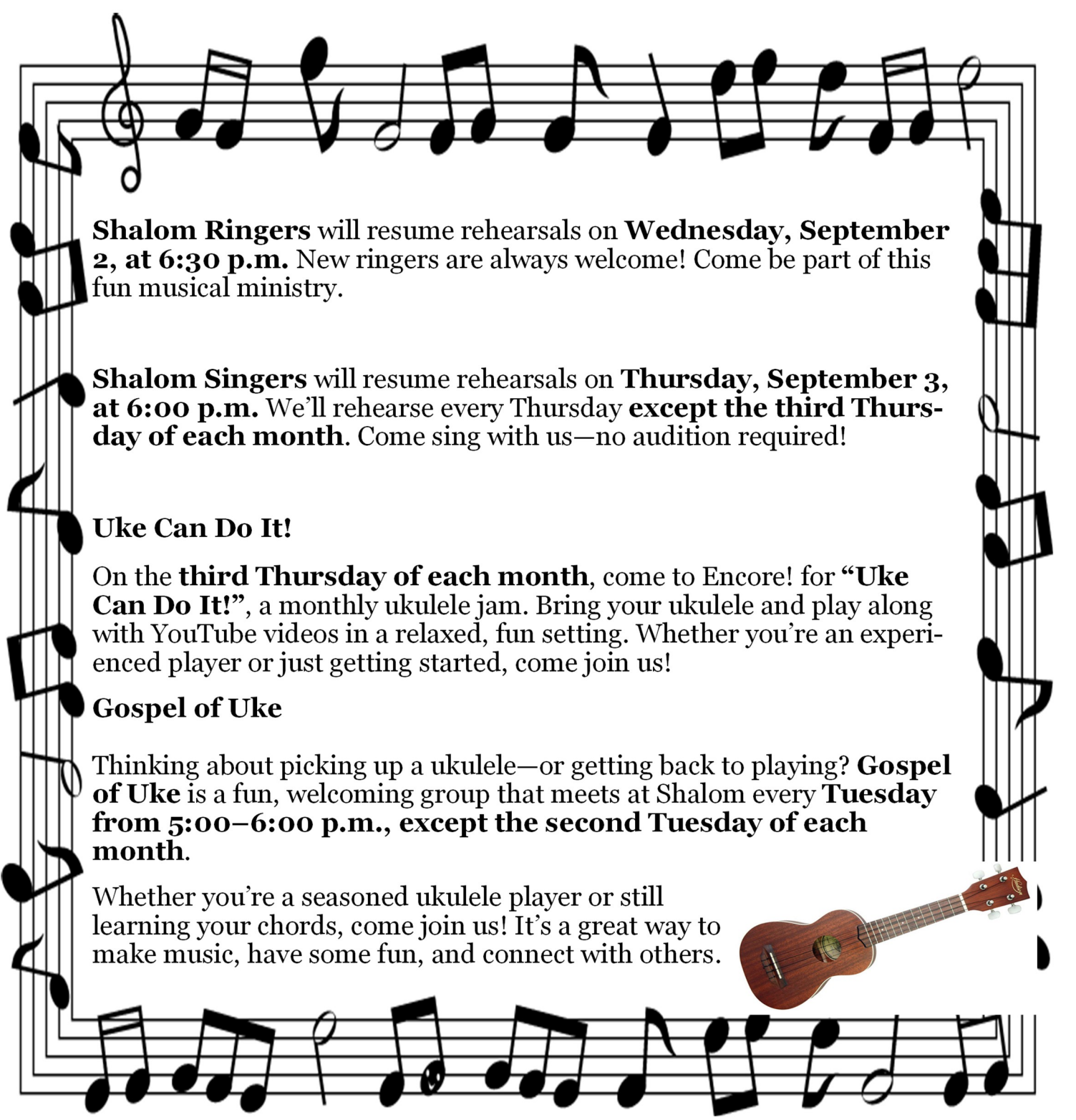


ENDOWMENT FUND
