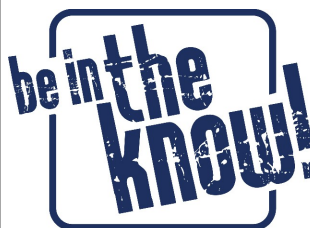

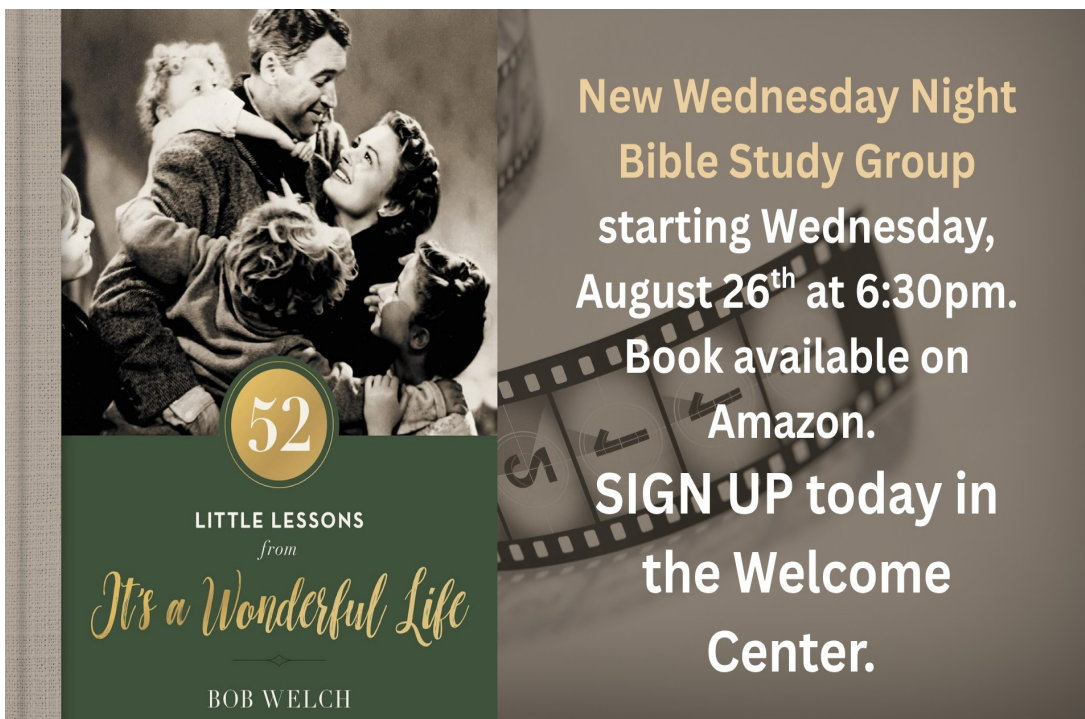

KEEPING THE WINDOWS TO THE WORLD HEALTHY - BY MELANIE CRAWFORD (NURSE'S PARISH)

It is interesting that one of the biggest health fears is blindness. Regular vision care can help stop that fear from becoming a reality. Regular checkups can keep our eyes healthy longer. Here are 8 things you can do to help protect your vision.

♦ **Find an eye doctor you can trust** – Ask friends or your insurance company. Ask how

often you need a dilated eye exam.

- ♦ **Add more movement to your day** - Physical activity can lower your risk for health conditions that can affect your vision.
- ♦ **Talk to your family about eye health history**- Glaucoma and age-related macular degeneration can run in families.
- ♦ **Eat Healthy** – Good foods can prevent diabetes or high blood pressure which in turn untreated can cause eye damage.
- ♦ **Wear sunglasses** even when its cloudy- UV Rays can harm your eyes.
- ♦ **Manage your diabetes and high blood pressure** – This helps lower your risk of vision loss.
- ♦ **Quit Smoking** – This can help lower the risk of macular degeneration and cataracts
