Former President Ronald Reagan once said,

Good advise from Brother Jack Wood,

In 1991 when I first started with VBP a project of John/Romans for Russia was already in the making. At that time I felt that we should be giving every person a whole Bible, so I asked Brother Jack Wood what he thought about just printing portions of Scripture and not the whole Bible. Brother Wood replied, ***"If you can put one verse of Scripture on a piece of paper and get it to Russia, get it there as quick as you can."*** The Lord used that one statement from Brother Wood to put an urgency of getting the gospel to the world in my heart that has stayed with me until this very day,

Not long after getting the help from Brother Wood I was in a church in Mexico where the pastor was having some of their preacher boys stand and quote a verse of Scripture. Most of them still had their Bible in their hand and some of them would read the verse rather than quote from memory. All of a sudden an older man stood, but he didn't have a Bible, so he took a gospel tract out of his shirt pocket and very carefully unfolded it and read a verse of Scripture from the tract and took his seat. After the service I went to the old man and ask to see the tract, and when I looked on the back it said, ***"Fellowship Tract League, Lebanon, Ohio."*** That one experience has helped me realize that whether they print gospel tracts, Scripture portions or whole Bibles, every fundamental, Bible Believing church that has a printing ministry, or supports those that do plays a vital part in fulfilling the great commission.

If you are a faithful supporter of VBP the Lord has used you to help us supply literally millions of John/Romans booklets for mission fields at home and abroad. We are currently finishing up a full container load of discipleship material, whole Bibles and 246,500 English John Romans for missionary Isaiah Carr in Zambia. All that's now left on the shelves is a little over 26,000 Spanish J/Rs that won't last very long until they too will be shipped to some needy mission field of the world.

We don't have room enough to report on the thousands of whole Bibles that are being shipped to some needy mission field every week. One shipment that needs prayed for is the 10,000 military edition Bibles that has been shipped to missionary Gerald Sutek in the Philippine Islands and scheduled to arrive the first week in September.
