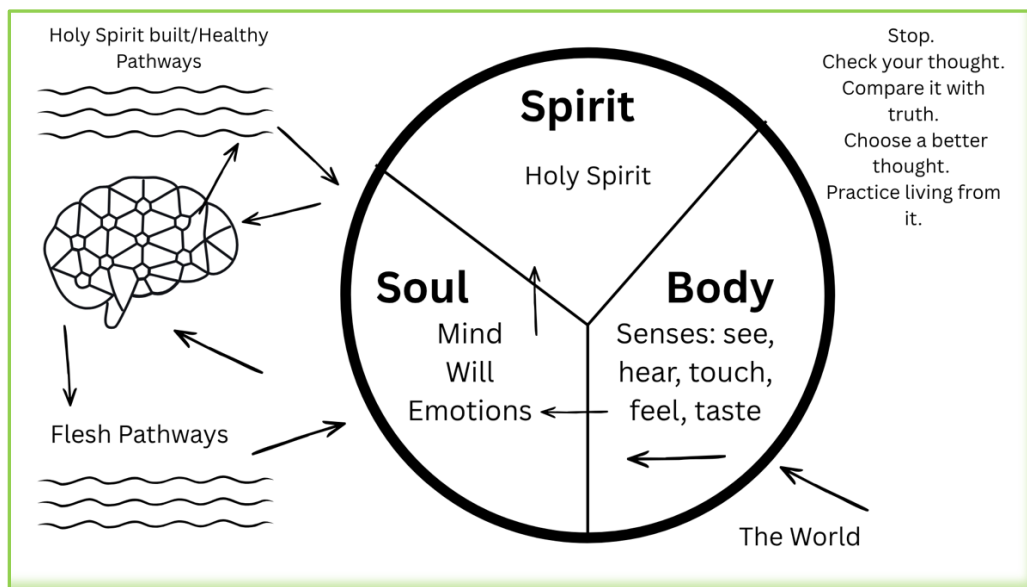

Principles We Practice

ABIDING:	Right Position

Ephesians 3:20 (TLB) Now glory be to God, who by his mighty power at work within us is able to do far more than we would ever dare to ask or even dream of—ininitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, or hopes.

Romans 12:1-2 (NTFE) So, my dear family, this is my appeal to you by the mercies of God: offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God. That's what properly thought-out worship looks like. What's more, don't let yourselves be squeezed into the shape dictated by the present age. Instead, be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you can work out what God's will is, what is good, acceptable and complete.



Ask - Answer - Discuss (Talk to the Word & let the Word talk to you)

- Read the Word & ask questions that come to mind (writing is helpful).
- Answer by applying the passage to your questions (no wrong answers, talk to the text, think about the questions you wrote down & answer them honestly & realistically. Your answers are shaped by your experiences and the unique way you think, feel & choose).
- Discuss examine your own thoughts, words & actions in light of the passage discussing the ways you can do what Scripture is telling you to do.

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Ask - Answer - Discuss

Galatians 6:7-9 (NTFE) Don't be misled; God won't have people turning their noses up at him. What you sow is what you'll reap. Yes: if you sow in the field of your flesh you will harvest decay from your flesh, but if you sow in the field of the spirit you will harvest eternal life from the spirit. Don't lose your enthusiasm for behaving properly. You'll bring in the harvest at the proper time, if you don't become weary.

Ask - Answer - Discuss

James 1:19-22 (NTFE) So, my dear brothers and sisters, get this straight. Every person should be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger. Human anger, you see, doesn't produce God's justice! So put away everything that is sordid, all overflowing malice, and humbly receive the word which has been planted within you and which has the power to rescue your lives. But be people who do the word, not merely people who hear it and deceive themselves.

Ask - Answer - Discuss

New Idea —> Permanent Pathway

Awareness: Hold on, this might have value!

Pondering: I need to find out more: books, podcasts, sermons, conversations

Value: I really believe it's important! (small/surface level changes)

*****HUGE GAP*****

Prioritize: Reordering of our time, energy & schedules to integrate these new values

Own It: All my decisions and actions are based on this new value (it is an integrated part of my life)

HOPE SHOT: The power to renew our mind is possible because God has designed our minds to be capable of doing so. We use his power, not our own. Ephesians 3:20

Practical Steps:

Spend time with Jesus. (Scripture, Prayer, Silence) Philippians 4:6-9, Colossians 3:1-2

Stop trying to do it on your own. John 15:4-5, 2 Corinthians 10:4-5

Do not grow weary, in due time, you will see change. Galatians 6:7-9
