Collect of the Day

Presider: Let us pray,

All: O God,
whose word burns like a fire within us:
grant us a bold and faithful spirit,
so that, in your strength,
we may be unafraid to speak your word
and follow where you lead;
through our Lord Jesus Christ;
who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
God for ever and ever. Amen.

The Epistle: Romans 12:9-21

Reader: The Epistle is taken from Paul's Letter to the Romans,

⁹Let love be genuine; hate what is evil, hold fast to what is good; ¹⁰love one another with mutual affection; outdo one another in showing honour. ¹¹Do not lag in zeal, be ardent in spirit, serve the Lord. ¹²Rejoice in hope, be patient in suffering, persevere in prayer. ¹³Contribute to the needs of the saints; extend hospitality to strangers.

¹⁴Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse them. ¹⁵Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep. ¹⁶Live in harmony with one another; do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly; do not claim to be wiser than you are. ¹⁷Do not repay anyone evil for evil, but take thought for what is noble in the sight of all. ¹⁸If it is possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all. ¹⁹Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave room for the wrath of God; for it is written, 'Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord.' ²⁰No, 'if your enemies are hungry, feed them; if they are thirsty, give them something to drink; for by doing this you will heap burning coals on their heads.' ²¹Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

Gradual Psalm: 105:1-6 & 23-26 (said responsively)

¹ O give thanks unto the LORD, and call upon his Name; /
tell the peoples what things he hath done.

² O let your songs be of him and praise him; /
and let your talking be of all his wondrous works.

³ Rejoice in his holy Name: /
let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD.

⁴ Seek the LORD and his strength: /
seek his face evermore.

⁵ Remember the marvellous works that he hath done, /
his wonders, and the judgements of his mouth;

⁶ O ye seed of Abraham his servant, /
ye children of Jacob, his chosen.

²³ Israel also came into Egypt, /
and Jacob was a stranger in the land of Ham.

²⁴ And the LORD increased his people exceedingly, /
and made them stronger than their enemies;

²⁵ Whose heart turned to hate his people, /
and to deal deceitfully with his servants.

²⁶ Then sent he Moses his servant, /
and Aaron whom he had chosen.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Ghost,
As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be,
world without end. Amen.

The Gospel: Matthew 16:21-28

Presider: The Lord be with you,

All: and with thy Spirit.

Presider: The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Matthew.

All: Glory be to thee, O Lord.

²¹ From that time on, Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and undergo great suffering at the hands of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised. ²² And Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him, saying, 'God forbid it, Lord! This must never happen to you.' ²³ But he turned and said to Peter, 'Get behind me, Satan! You are a stumbling-block to me; for you are setting your mind not on divine things but on human things.'

²⁴ Then Jesus told his disciples, 'If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. ²⁵ For those who want to save their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it. ²⁶ For what will it profit them if they gain the whole world but forfeit their life? Or what will they give in return for their life?

²⁷ 'For the Son of Man is to come with his angels in the glory of his Father, and then he will repay everyone for what has been done. ²⁸ Truly I tell you, there are some standing here who will not taste death before they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom.'
