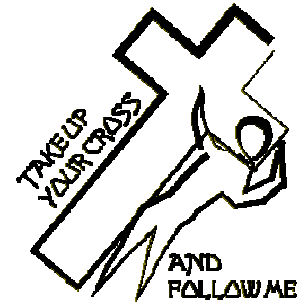

Today's lessons:

- Exodus 3:1-15 God appears to Moses in a burning bush and tells him that he is to be the leader of Israel. Moses' protest is futile — God has chosen him for the task and will not let him go alone!
- Psalm 105:1-6, 23-26, 45b From Abraham to Moses and Aaron, all through the time Israel spent in Egypt, God has been with his people.
- Romans 12:9-21 To live a Christian life means to show compassion, humility and patience to everyone, but especially to pay back evil with good. Peter doesn't want Jesus to suffer evil and death. This seems to be a logical consequence of his love for Jesus. But Jesus sees it as evil temptation!

I'M NOT THE SAME AS YOU.

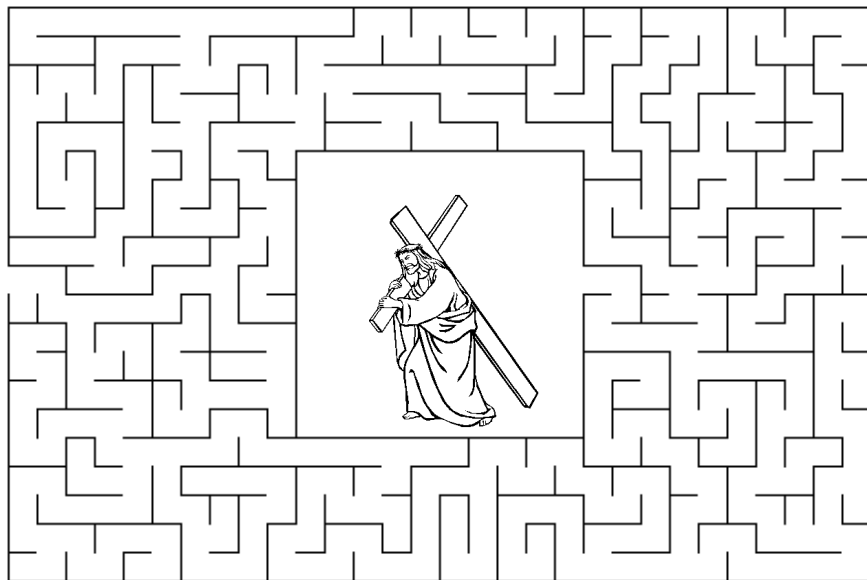
Or have I confused the whole thing, and it was:
