STUDY TWO EXODUS 3:1-4:17

Read Exodus 3:1-10

Moses encounters God in a way he could never have expected: a bush that burns without being consumed, and the voice of God calling his name.

1. What stands out to you about the way God reveals himself to Moses?
2. What do Moses' response and God's words about "holy ground" teach us about who God is and how we should approach him?
3. What do these verses tell us about God's heart toward people who are suffering?

Moses expresses several doubts in response to God's calling.

4. Read through each 'doubt' and God's response (passages overleaf) and answer the following questions for each passage.

- a) **What is Moses' doubt/excuse?**
- b) **How does God respond? What is God teaching Moses?**
- c) **How do we hold similar doubts in our own lives and calling as disciples of Jesus?**
- d) **How does God response guide and challenge us as disciples of Jesus?**

Doubt/Response 1 - Read Exodus 3:11-12

Doubt/Response 2 - Read Exodus 3:13-22

Doubt/Response 3 - Read Exodus 4:1-9

Doubt/Response 4 - Read Exodus 4:10-12

5. Which of Moses' doubts do you most identify with, and why?

6. What is one area of obedience or mission where you need to stop focusing on what you lack and instead trust who God is?
