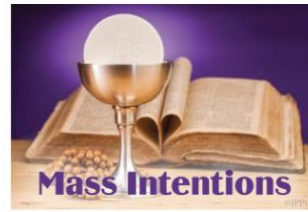

CHURCH CHATTER

As we enjoy the last of the summer wine, it is a good time to look back on a very fruitful and pleasant summer. These summer days certainly go fast and we accomplished a lot. When you enter the parking lot, you notice that the parking lot lining is back in place and it was done in one day. Now we have order and direction. Please use the entrance and exit routes appropriately when there are large gatherings. Lets not run into each other! Also, the lawn cutting crew has done a wonderful job keeping up appearances here on our large estate. Caring for our lawn makes us look like responsible and caring neighbors. Also, our garden club makes our Church look rather sophisticated and cared for. A very small group of people make our parish property shine and tingle. Thank you so much. It makes a grand difference.

The car show was another success this year with over 330 cars participating. The weather cooperated and the number of viewers was also good. All the people who made this possible are to be commended for their organizational skills and their spirit of charity for the parish. Thank you indeed! I believe we raised about fifteen thousand dollars total which will be put to good use.

The Church roof got a good looking at and we do believe that the vast majority of leaks have been dealt with. That is with regular weather. I do believe that with some of the more-heavy and longer rain storms about two (2) leaks seem to resurface. Some things just won't go away no matter what. During those heavy and longer down-pours the roof looks like a waterfall; pretty but problematic. The chapel air conditioning has been replaced. It was the original machine for 1989 and finally went kaput during the heat wave. The new system is working well, thank you!

We also got a new phone system for the parish campus. It is easier to use and after a few tweaks is working well also. I do believe that this will last us awhile.

At this time of year, we also look ahead. As the season of Autumn approaches, we know that all of the usual activities start to kick in with School and PREP and holidays and sports and so many other things that keep us busy. We are looking to cover the walkway in front of the social hall with a roof to help reduce the amount of rain and ice that develops there this time of year. It won't match the roof line but it will be effective. We are also going to be putting in road signs so that we will know where to enter and exit and turn and where the office is. That is another fall project. There is also going to be a ministry fair this fall to recruit new and more people into these activities and so many more so as to sustain the good works we do and to develop new and more activities and ministries such as ChristLife which begins this fall. More on this coming up.

I am grateful for all you do for our parish. We are small and simple but we are also effective in what we do. It's all because you make a difference with your time and talents and treasure. We ain't the biggest parish. We ain't the richest parish. We are the secret garden of the Archdiocese where you can find Jesus in your neighbor.

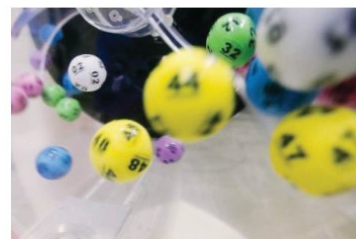

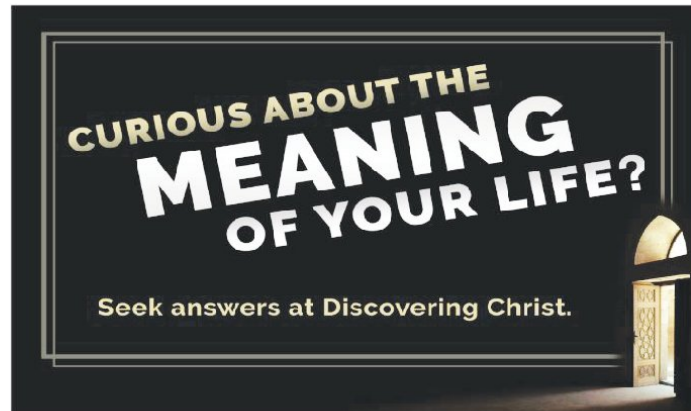
