

The Believer's Consideration of One Another Hebrews 10:19-25 (September 13, 2026)

1. What is the main idea of the command in verse 24, and what are two to three practical ways this command is lived out among believers?
2. From verse 25, what will distract or prevent one's obedience to this command? What are some reasons that this can become a temptation for a believer, and what can you do to prevent that in your own life?
3. In verse 25, as the preacher transitions from the negative command, indicated by the word "but," what good habits are believers to put into practice?
4. From Hebrews 9:27-38 and 10:25, Matthew 24:42-44, and 1 Thessalonians 4:16-18, what day is drawing near?
5. How should understanding that this day is drawing near motivate believers "all the more" to obey this specific command? How does 2 Peter 3:11-18 practically direct the believer to do that?
6. In this study, we have reexamined some of the preacher's arguments laid out in earlier chapters of Hebrews and considered the application in our lives. What has specifically encouraged you or challenged you this week?
