Psalm 29:1-2, *“Ascribe to the Lord, O sons of the mighty, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength.
² Ascribe to the Lord the glory due to His name; worship the Lord in holy array.”*

Ascribe: to fulfill one’s covenant obligation to entrust oneself to the Lord.

Psalm 29:3, *“The voice of the Lord is upon the waters; the God of glory thunders.”*

Psalm 29:4, *“The voice of the Lord is powerful; the voice of the Lord is majestic.”*

Psalm 29:5, *“The voice of the Lord breaks the cedars; yes, the Lord breaks in pieces the cedars of Lebanon.”*

Psalm 29:6, *“He makes Lebanon skip like a calf, and Sirion like a young wild ox.”*

Psalm 29:7, *“The voice of the Lord hews out flames of fire.”*

Psalm 29:8, *“The voice of the Lord shakes the wilderness; the lord shakes the wilderness of Kadesh.”*

Psalm 29:9, *“The voice of the Lord makes the deer to calve and strips the forests bare; and in His temple everything says, “Glory!”*

Psalm 29:10, *“The Lord sat as King at the flood; yes, the Lord sits as King forever.”*

Psalm 29:11, *“The Lord will give strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace.”*

Peace: wholeness, completeness, tranquility, and covenant harmony

Hebrews 1:2, *“In these last days (God) has spoken to us in His Son.”*

Matthew 14:24-26, *“The boat was battered by the waves, the wind was contrary. ²⁵ Jesus came to them, walking on the sea. ²⁶ When the disciples saw Jesus walking on the sea, they were terrified, and said, “It is a ghost!” And they cried out in fear.”*

Matthew 14:32-33, *“When Peter and Jesus got into the boat, the wind stopped. ³³ And those who were in the boat worshiped Him, saying, “You are certainly God’s Son!”*

John 16:27; 33, *“The Father Himself loves you. ³³ These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have trouble, but take courage; I have overcome the world.”*
