FAMILY DEVOTION

I'M IN TROUBLE: "His Strength Is Perfect"



"I May Be Weak, But My God Is Strong!"

SAY:

We live in a world that glorifies strength and power! People are obsessed with being stronger, braver, more powerful, more fit, more successful.... The stronger you are or the more powerful you are, the more successful and liked you will be.

That's what the world says, but that's the opposite of what God says. God says His power works best when we're weak!

READ:

Judges 16

DISCUSS:

- Who is the strongest man in the Bible?
- Who did Samson fall in love with?
- Who paid Delilah to trick Samson into telling her the secret to his power?
- What happened when they cut Samson's hair?
- What happened when God gave Samson strength one last time?

SAY:

God's power came through for Samson in his weakest moment. God came through for Samson, and He will come through for us every time! God's strength never runs out - His strength is perfect!

DISCUSS:

- Do you remember a time when God came through for you when you were at your weakest?

PRAY:

Pray that while your children may feel weak or inadequate, they remember that God is strong and His strength never runs out!
