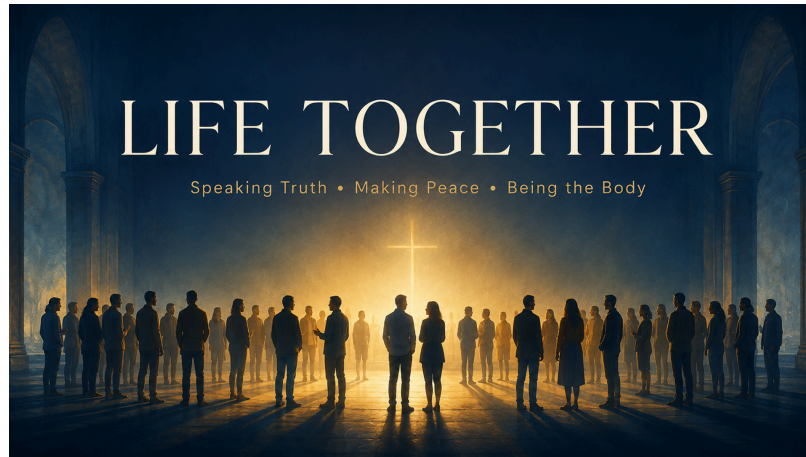

Our fellowship time takes place after the service in our Fellowship Hall, located at the rear of the building. To get there, exit the Sanctuary through the rear doors, follow the hallway to the right, and then take a quick left. You'll notice the bathrooms and a drinking fountain to your right as soon as you exit the Sanctuary.

Sunday School, for children in preschool through 6th grade. Drop-off begins at 8:50 AM in Room 1 (Preschool-2nd grade) and Room 2 (3rd-6th grade) and Sunday School begins at 9:00 AM.
