When I did and found out I was eligible, I went with him and Rebecca last year - my first time. (I would have never gone on my own or without their support)

The experience wasn't at all as frightening as I had imagined it to be, in fact the incredible feeling of literally Living Out Gods Love filled my heart and soul to the point that I have made a personal commitment to give blood on a regular basis.
