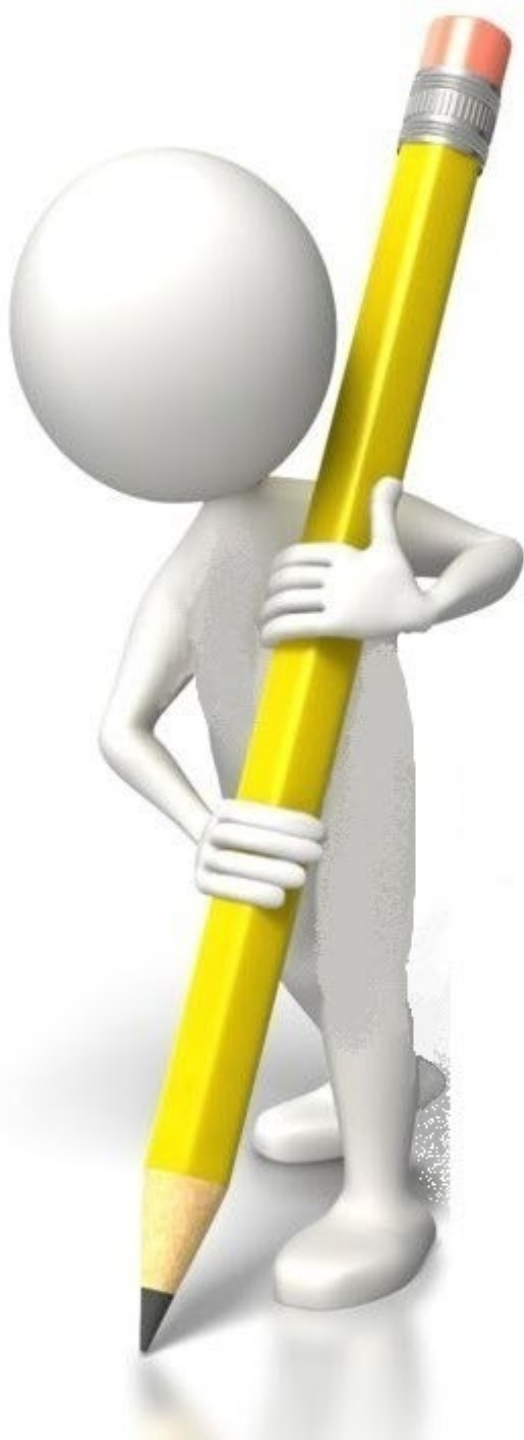

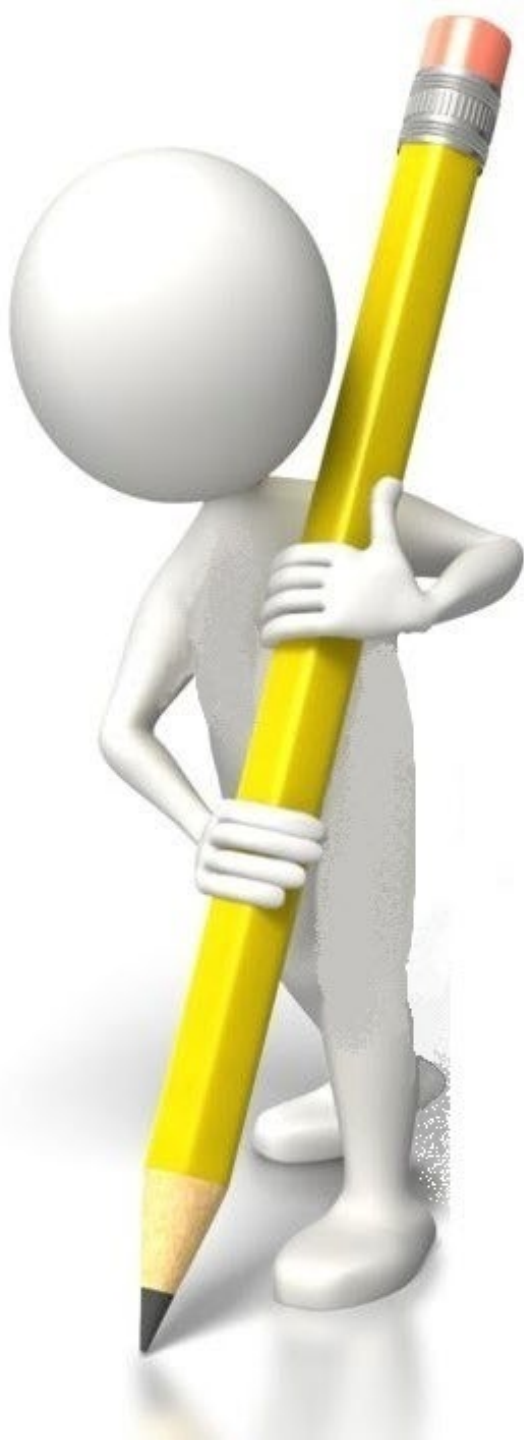

Luke 10:29-36 [Voice] The scholar was frustrated by this response because he was hoping to make himself appear smarter than Jesus.

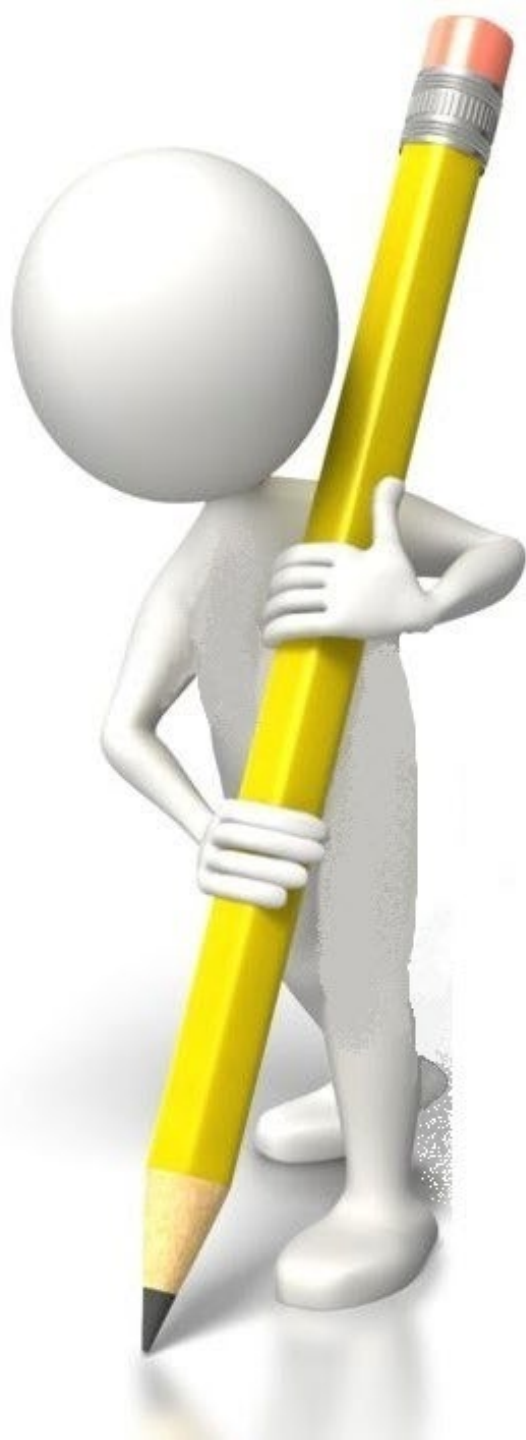
Scholar: Ah, but who is my neighbor?
