SERMON: Hebrews 10:1-18 | Forever Forgiven

MAIN IDEA: Jesus's superior sacrifice _____ achieves what the repeated sacrifices of the old covenant never could: forgiveness of sins.

2. **Jesus's sacrifice _____ the Father's will. (vv.5-10)**

Adjust: Are you being sanctified? Do you draw near to God in full assurance of _____ in Jesus's perfect sacrifice?

Application Questions:

1. Explain the relationship between the old covenant and sacrifices. Why did God institute the sacrificial system? If animal sacrifices were ultimately insufficient, what purpose did they serve?
2. Why does the writer of Hebrews point out that the Old Covenant sacrifices served as a reminder of sin rather than providing full forgiveness? What conclusion does he reach about the effectiveness of animal sacrifices, specifically the blood of bulls and goats?
3. What foundational difference between the Old and New Covenants does the writer of Hebrews highlight by quoting Jeremiah 31? Why is this distinction so significant for followers of Christ living under the New Covenant?
4. What conclusions does the writer of Hebrews draw regarding the sins of those for whom Jesus has offered Himself as a sacrifice? In what ways should these conclusions inspire great joy and delight in Jesus Christ?
