



Quiet Time Questions from August 30, 2026

Sermon in a Sentence: The Gospel matters because of sin.

Verse for Memorization and Meditation: *“For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”* (Romans 6:23)

1. Read Exodus 20:1-20. As I have gone through the standard for holiness, do I come up short? Is there only one True God in my life, or do I have idols that seem to take up more of my time and attention? Is my love for God reflected in how I talk about Him and rest in Him and His people in worship?

2. Read Exodus 20:1-20. Do I love my neighbor as myself by honoring my parents? Do I truly love others, or do I hate them, lust after them, take what is not my own, lie about them, and covet what they have?

3. Read 2 Corinthians 5. Will I admit that I have missed the mark when it comes to holiness? Will I stop comparing myself to others and compare myself to the One True God, who is holy? Will I trust in Christ’s holiness, His death, and resurrection to save me from my sin? And as a Christian, will I rely on the Holy Spirit and look to God’s standards of holiness as the true mark for my life?
