SAME PRESENCE

Joshua 1:1-9 (NKJV) After the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, it came to pass that the Lord spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, saying: ²"Moses My servant is dead. Now therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them—the children of Israel. ³Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given you, as I said to Moses. ⁴From the wilderness and this Lebanon as far as the great river, the River Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and to the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your territory. ⁵No man shall *be able to* stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, *so* I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you. ⁶Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall ^[a]divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. ⁷Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may ^[b]prosper wherever you go. ⁸This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you^[c] shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. ⁹Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God *is* with you wherever you go."

1 — GOD'S PRESENCE ISN'T ATTACHED TO A PERSON

Joshua 1:1–2

"After the death of Moses the servant of the LORD, the LORD said to Joshua..."

Make sure your faith is anchored in the One who promised, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."

2 — GOD'S PRESENCE IS FOR HIS PEOPLE

Wherever God's people go, we can live with the confidence that we don't go alone. His presence is for His people—and that includes you.

3 — GOD'S PRESENCE GIVES COURAGE FOR UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY

God's presence isn't the promise of an easy journey. It's the promise that we won't make the journey alone.

4 — GOD'S PRESENCE CALLS US TO KEEP FOLLOWING

If God is leading, our responsibility is to keep following—remaining faithful to His Word, open to His direction, and willing to take the next step together.
